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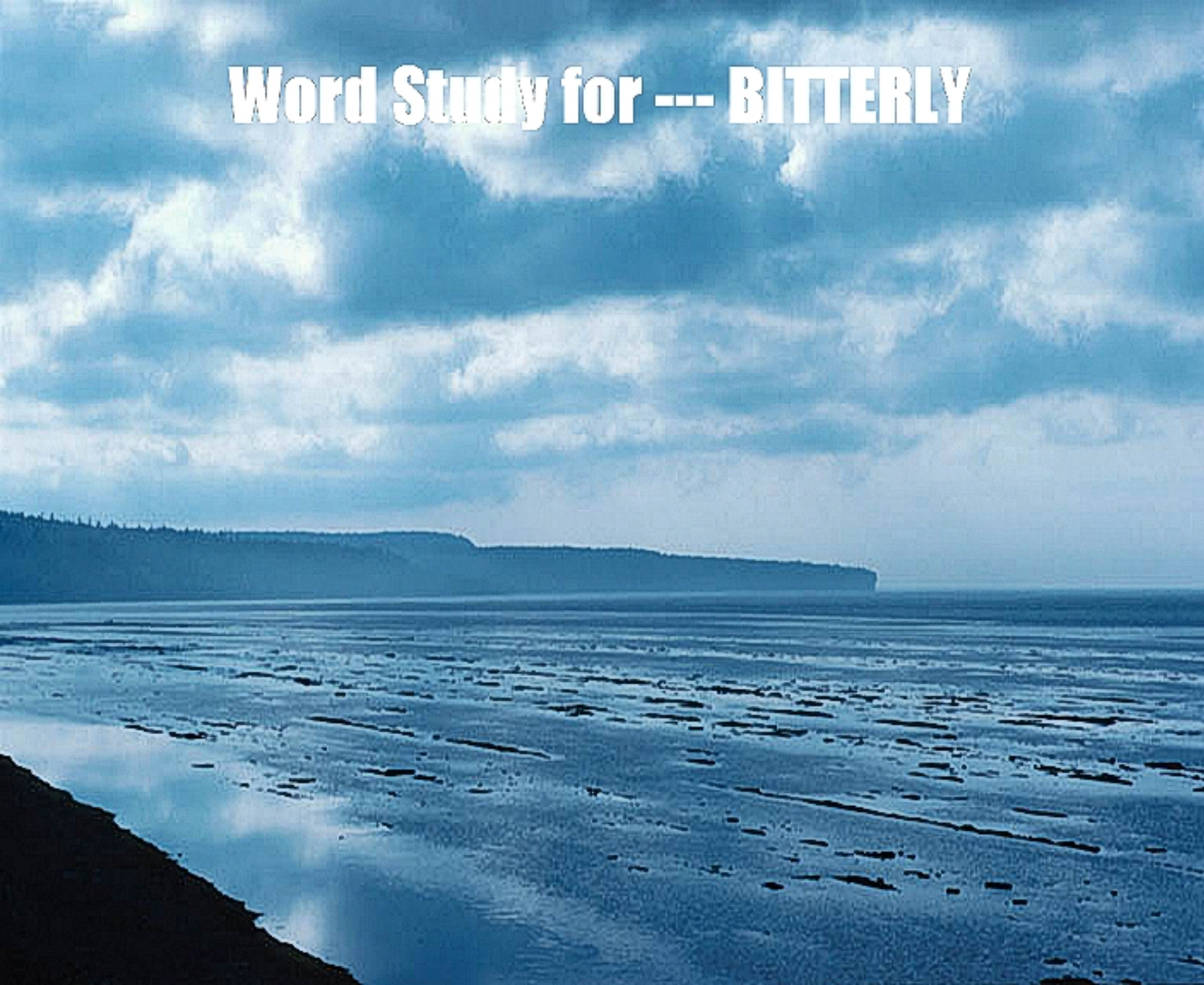
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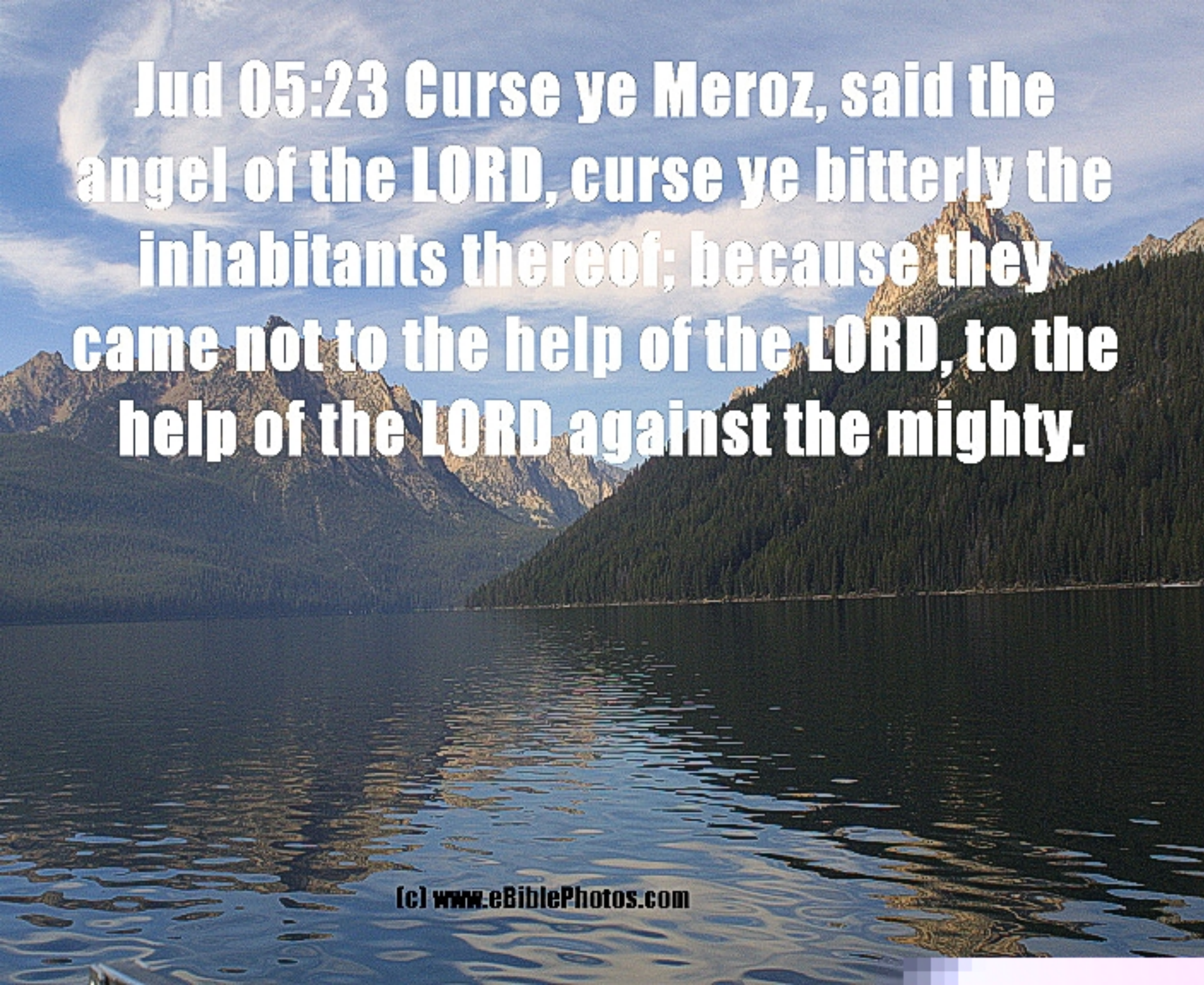

help of the LORD against the mighty.**

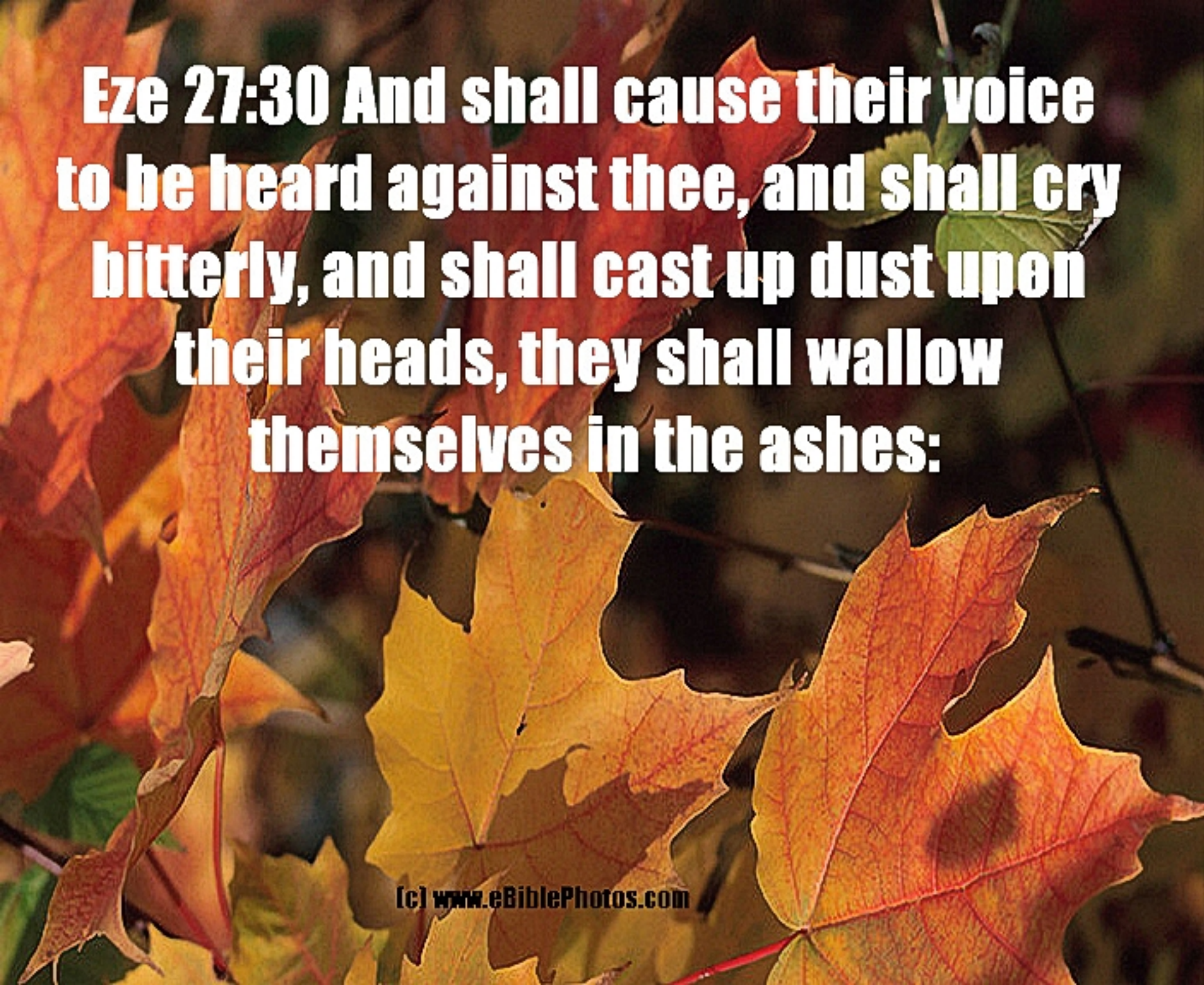
**Rut 01:20 And she said unto them, Call

peace shall weep bitterly.**

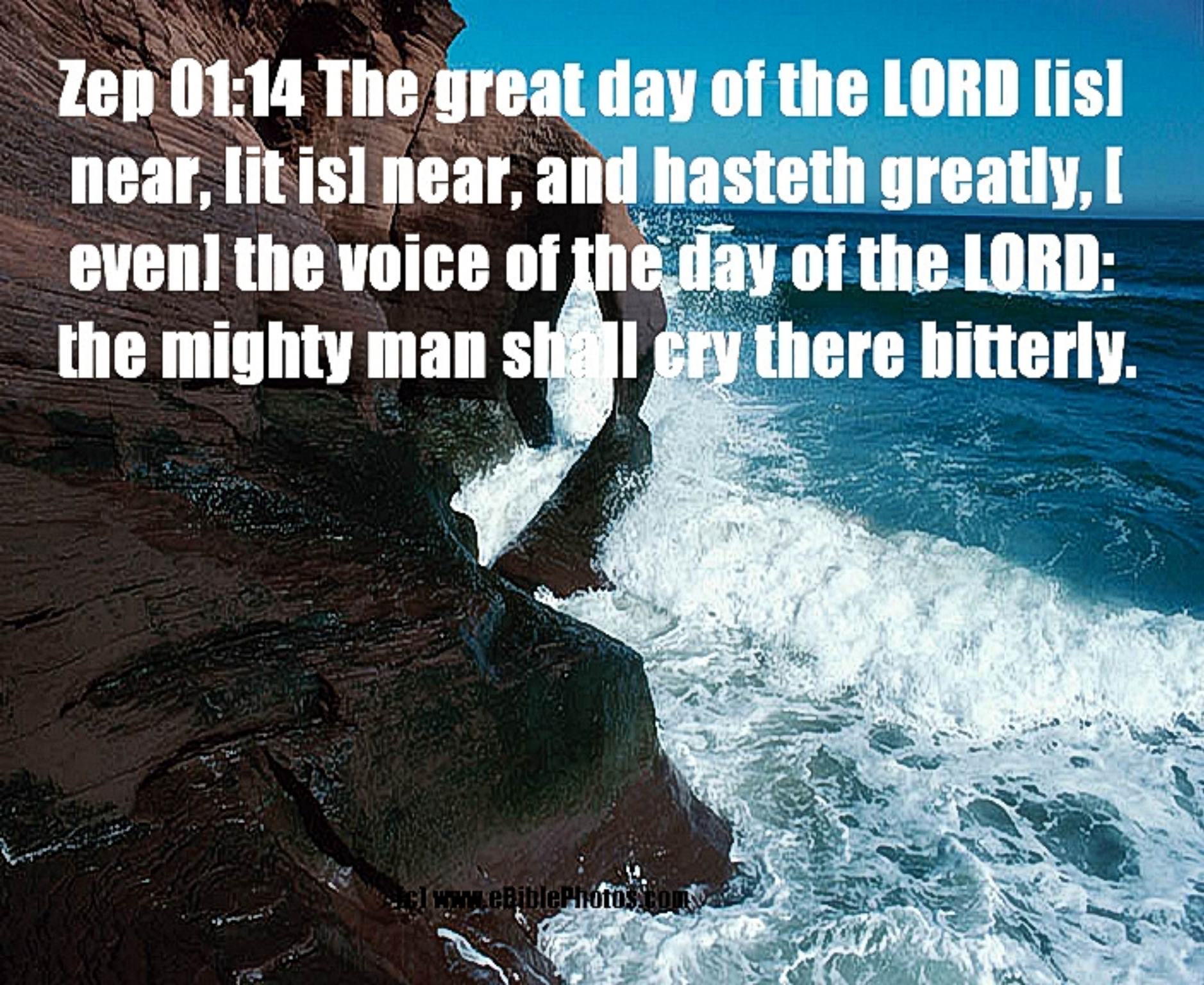




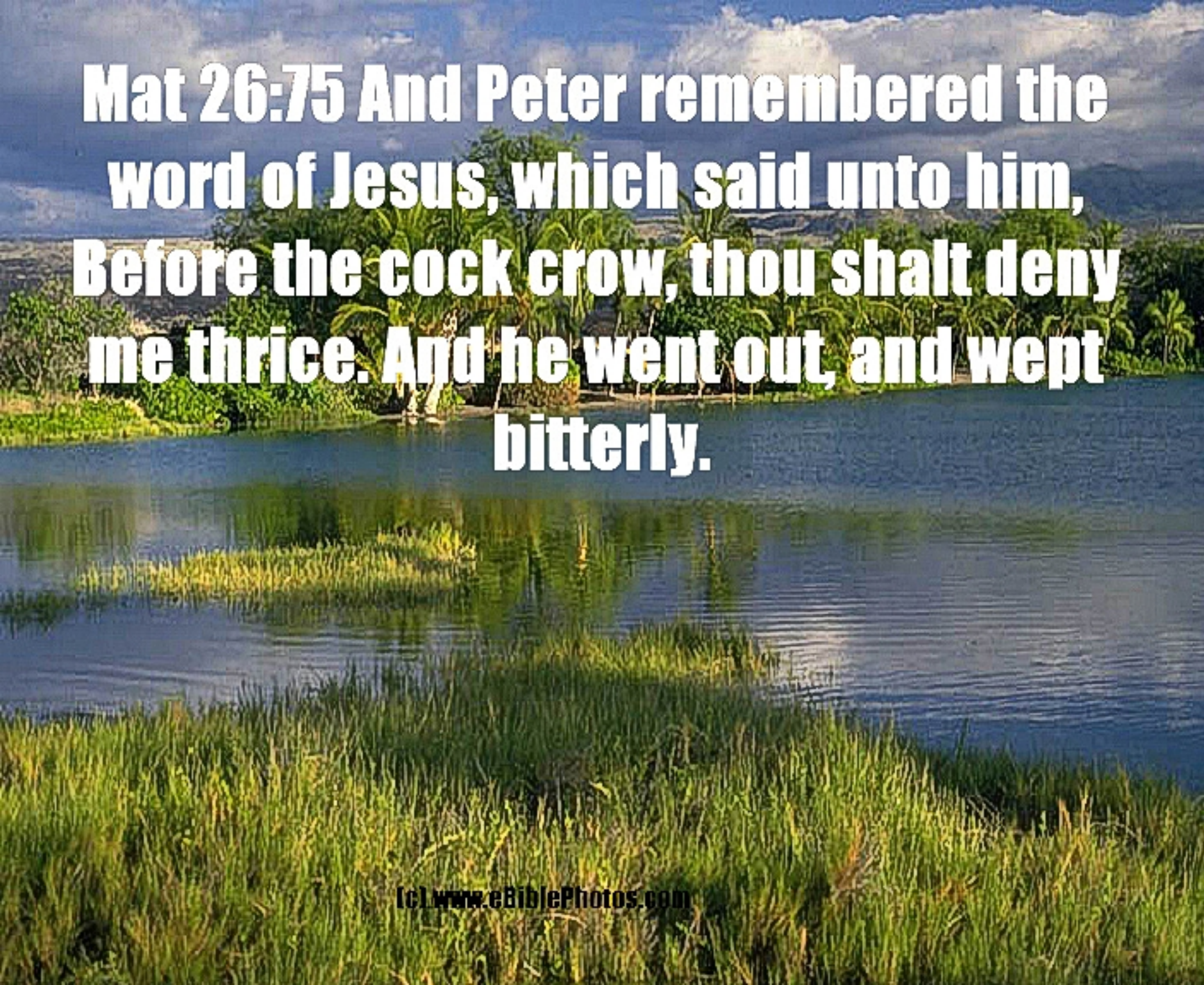
