Isaiah the prophet the son of Amoz.**



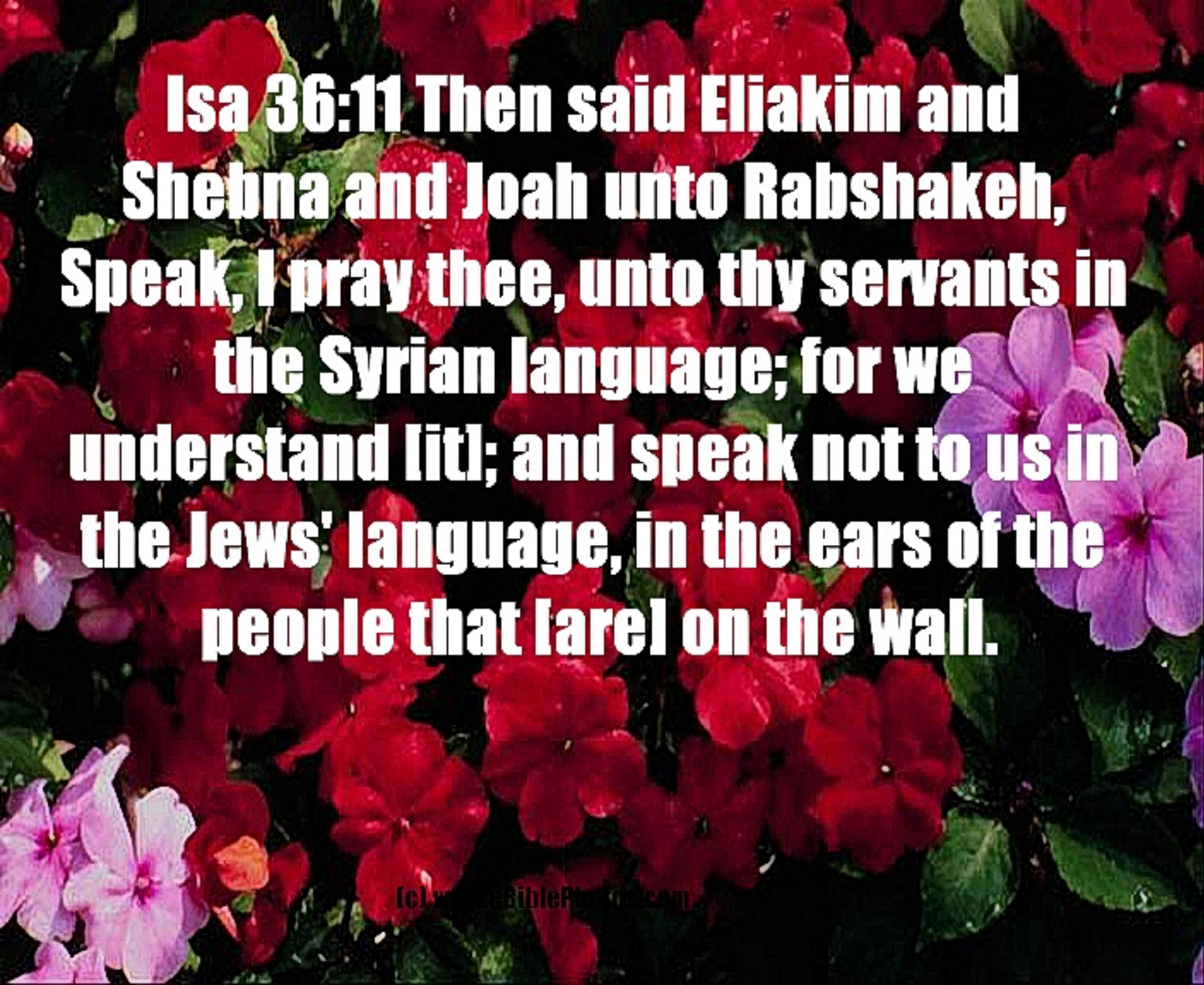

with trumpets;**

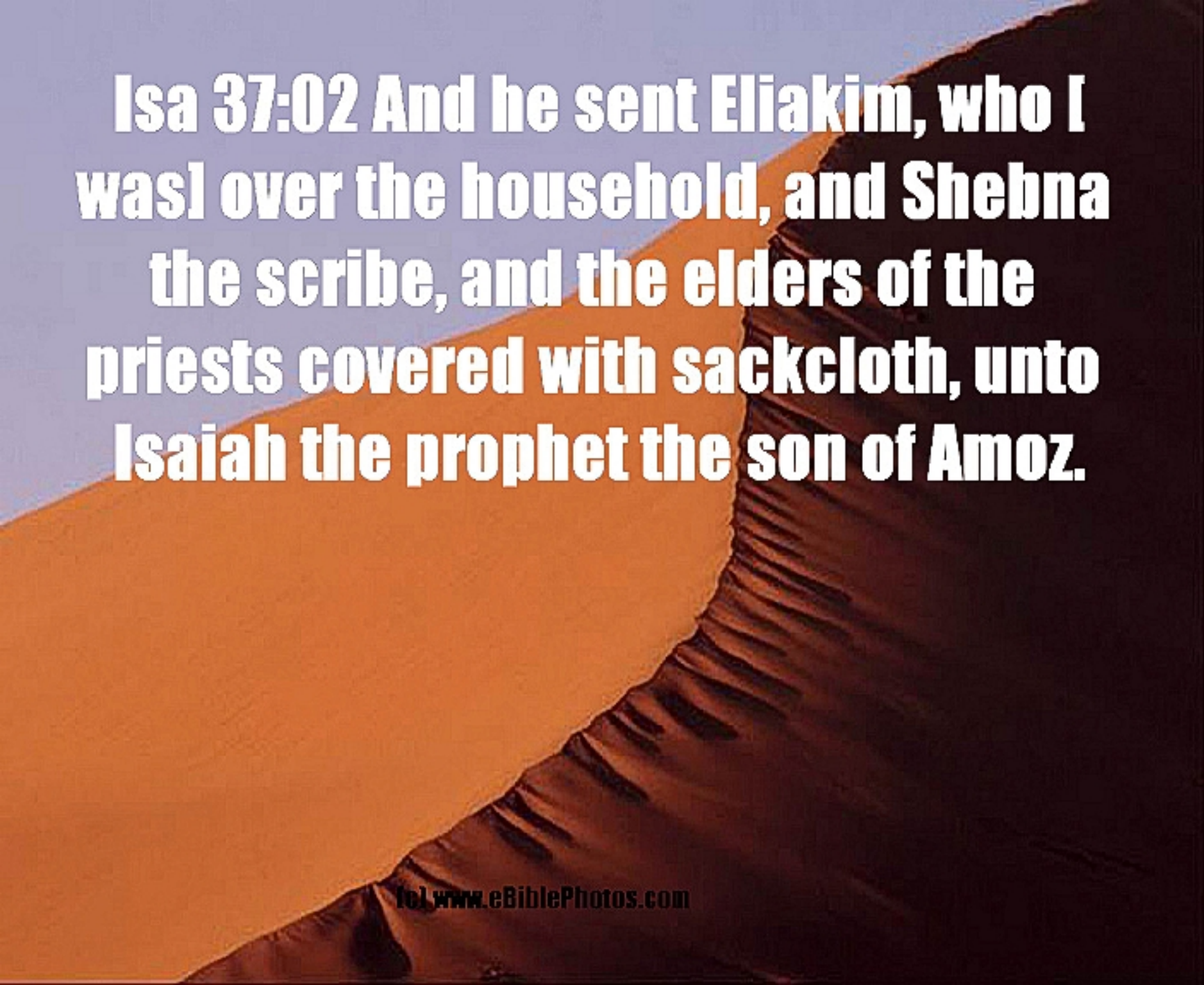
**Isa 22:20 And it shall come to pass in
