4_ACT_10:03 He saw in a vision evidently about the minth nour of the day an angel of God coming in to him a saying unto him, Cornelius.	1,

44_ACT_10:07 And when the angel which spake unto Cornelius was departed, he called two of his household servants, and a devout soldier of them that waited on him continually;

44_ACT_10:17 Now while Peter doubted in himself what this vision which he had seen should mean, behold, the men which were sent from Cornelius had made inquiry for Simon's house, and stood before the gate,

44_ACT_10:21 Then Peter went down to the men-which were sent unto him from Cornelius; and said, Behold, I am he whom ye seek: what [is] the cause wherefore ye are come?

And they said, Cornelius the centurion, a just man, and one that feareth God, and of good report among all the nation of the Jews, was warned from God by an holy angel to send for thee into his house, and to hear words of thee.

44_ACT_10:24 And the morrow after they entered into Caesarea. And Cornelius waited for them, and had called together his kinsmen and near friends.

44_ACT_10:25 And as Peter was coming in, Cornellus met himl, and fell down at his feet, and worshipped [him].

44_ACT_10:30 And Cornelius said, Four days ago Twas fasting until this hour; and at the ninth hour I prayed in my house, and, behold, a man stood before me in bright clothing,
