

Word Study for -- ACCUSE



**Pro 30:10 Accuse not a servant unto
his master, lest he curse thee, and
thou be found guilty.**

**Mat 12:10 And, behold, there was a man
which had [his] hand withered. And
they asked him, saying Is it lawful to
heal on the sabbath days? That they
might accuse him.**

**Mar 03:02 And they watched him,
whether he would heal him on the
sabbath day; that they might accuse
him.**

Luk 03:14 And the soldiers likewise demanded of him, saying, And what shall we do? And he said unto them, Do violence to no man, neither accuse any falsely; and be content with your wages.

Luk 11:54 Laying wait for him, and seeking to catch something out of his mouth, that they might accuse him.

Luk 23:02 And they began to accuse him, saying, We found this fellow perverting the nation, and forbidding to give tribute to Caesar, saying that he himself is Christ a King.

Luk 23:14 Said unto them, Ye have brought this man unto me, as one that perverteth the people: and, behold, I, having examined [him] before you, have found no fault in this man touching those things whereof ye accuse him:

**Joh 05:45 Do not think that I will
accuse you to the Father: there is [one]
that accuseth you, [even] Moses, in
whom ye trust.**

Joh 08:06 This they said, tempting him,
that they might have to accuse him.
But Jesus stooped down, and with [this]
finger wrote on the ground, [as though
he heard them not].

Act 24:02 And when he was called forth, Tertullus began to accuse [him], saying, Seeing that by thee we enjoy great quietness, and that very worthy deeds are done unto this nation by thy providence,

**Act 24:08 Commanding his accusers
to come unto thee: by examining of
whom thyself mayest take knowledge
of all these things, whereof we accuse
him.**

Act 24:13 Neither can they prove the things whereof they now accuse me.

**Act 25:05 Let them therefore, said he,
which among you are able, go down
with [me], and accuse this man, if
there be any wickedness in him.**

Act 25:11 For if I be an offender, or have committed any thing worthy of death, I refuse not to die: but if there be none of these things wherof these accuse me, no man may deliver me unto them.

I appeal unto Caesar.

**Act 28:19 But when the Jews spake
against [it], I was constrained to
appeal unto Caesar; not that I had
ought to accuse my nation of.**

**1Pe 03:16 Having a good conscience;
that, whereas they speak evil of you, as
of evildoers, they may be ashamed that
falsely accuse your good conversation
in Christ.**
