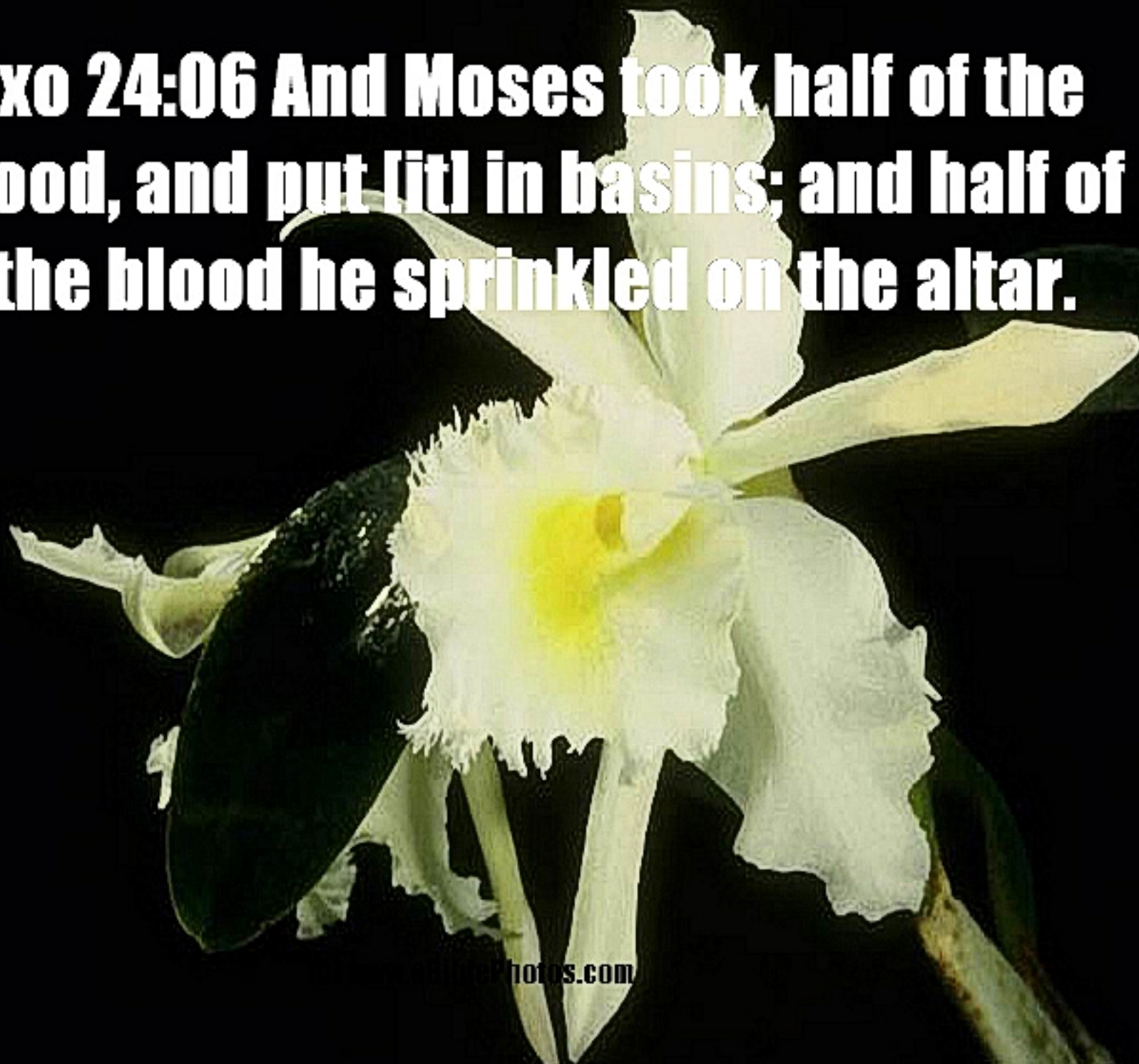







Exo 24:06 And Moses took half of the blood, and put [it] in basins; and half of the blood he sprinkled on the altar.


