
Exo 28:04 And these [are] the garments which they shall make; a breastplate, and an ephod, and a robe, and a brodered coat, a mitre, and a girdle: and they shall make holy garments for Aaron thy brother, and his sons, that he may minister unto me in the priest's office.




**Eze 16:10 I clothed thee also with

silk.**




