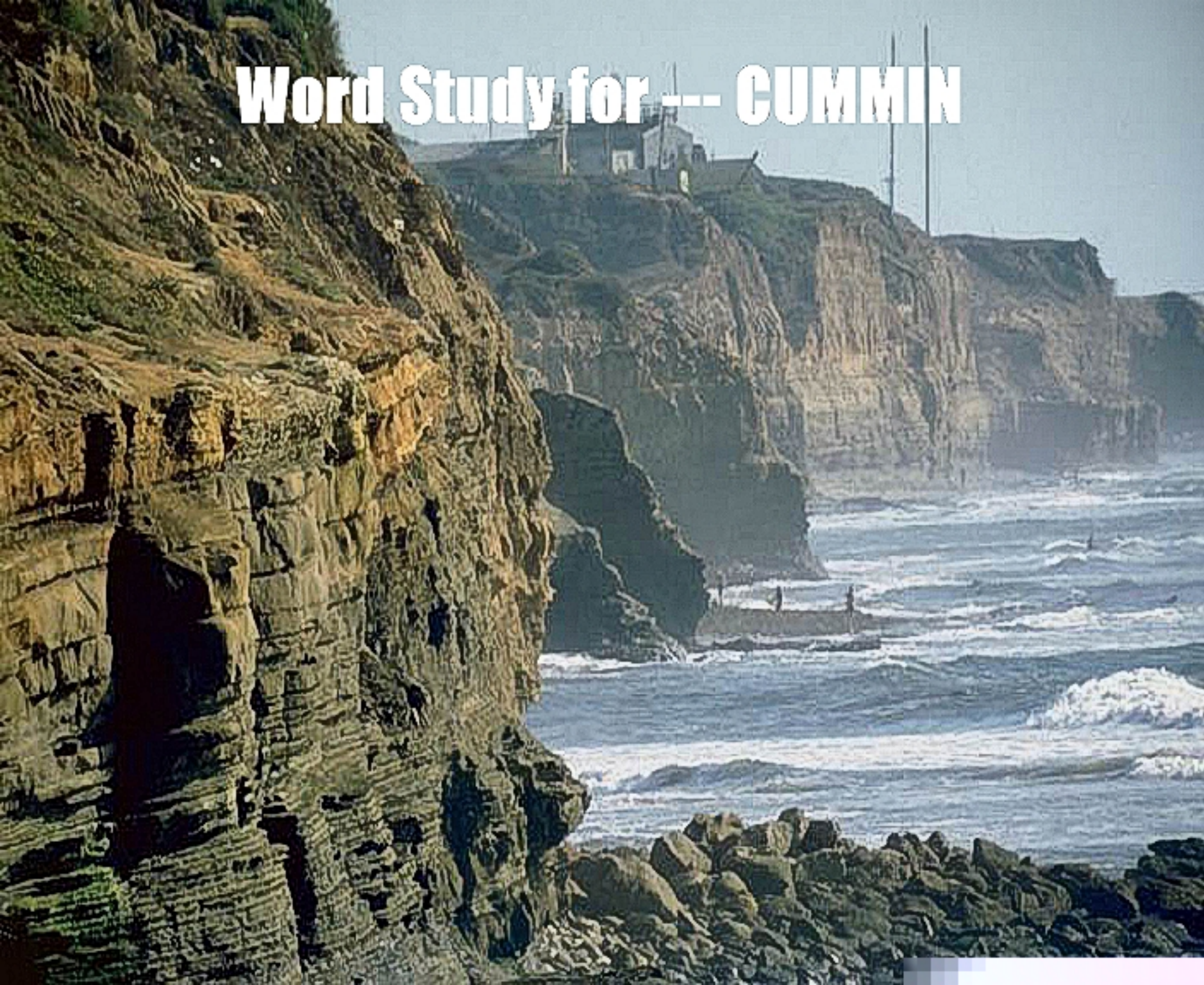








Word Study for --- CUMMIN


