

scriptures, came to Ephesus.**


**Act 19:01 And it came to pass, that,

**Act 19:17 And this was known to all the
Jews and Greeks also dwelling at

the name of the Lord Jesus was
magnified.**

**Act 19:26 Moreover ye see and hear,
that not alone at Ephesus, but almost
throughout all Asia, this Paul hath
persuaded and turned away much
people, saying that they be no gods,
which are made with hands:**

Act 19:35 And when the townclerk had appeased the people, he said, [Ye] men of Ephesus, what man is there that knoweth not how that the city of the Ephesians is a worshipper of the great goddess Diana, and of the [image] which fell down from Jupiter?

Act 20:16 For Paul had determined to sail by Ephesus, because he would not spend the time in Asia: for he hasted, if it were possible for him, to be at Jerusalem the day of Pentecost.



Act 20:17 And from Miletus he sent to Ephesus, and called the elders of the church.

**1Co 15:32 If after the manner of men I
have fought with beasts at Ephesus,
what advantageth it me, if the dead
rise not? Let us eat and drink; for to
morrow we die.**


**1Co 16:08 But I will tarry at Ephesus

knowest very well.**

2Ti 04:12 And Tychicus have I sent to Ephesus.



Rev 1:11 Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send [it] unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea.
