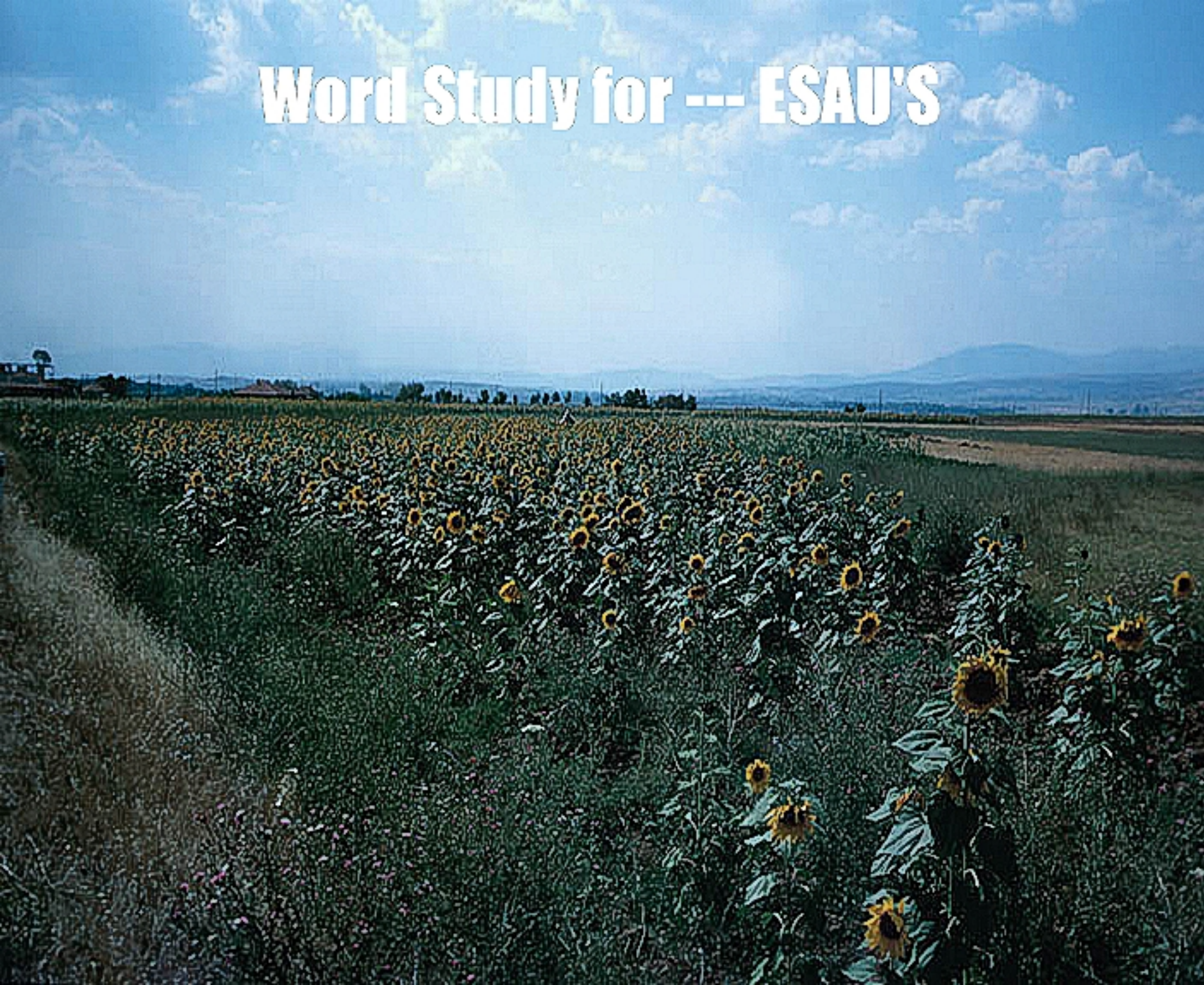

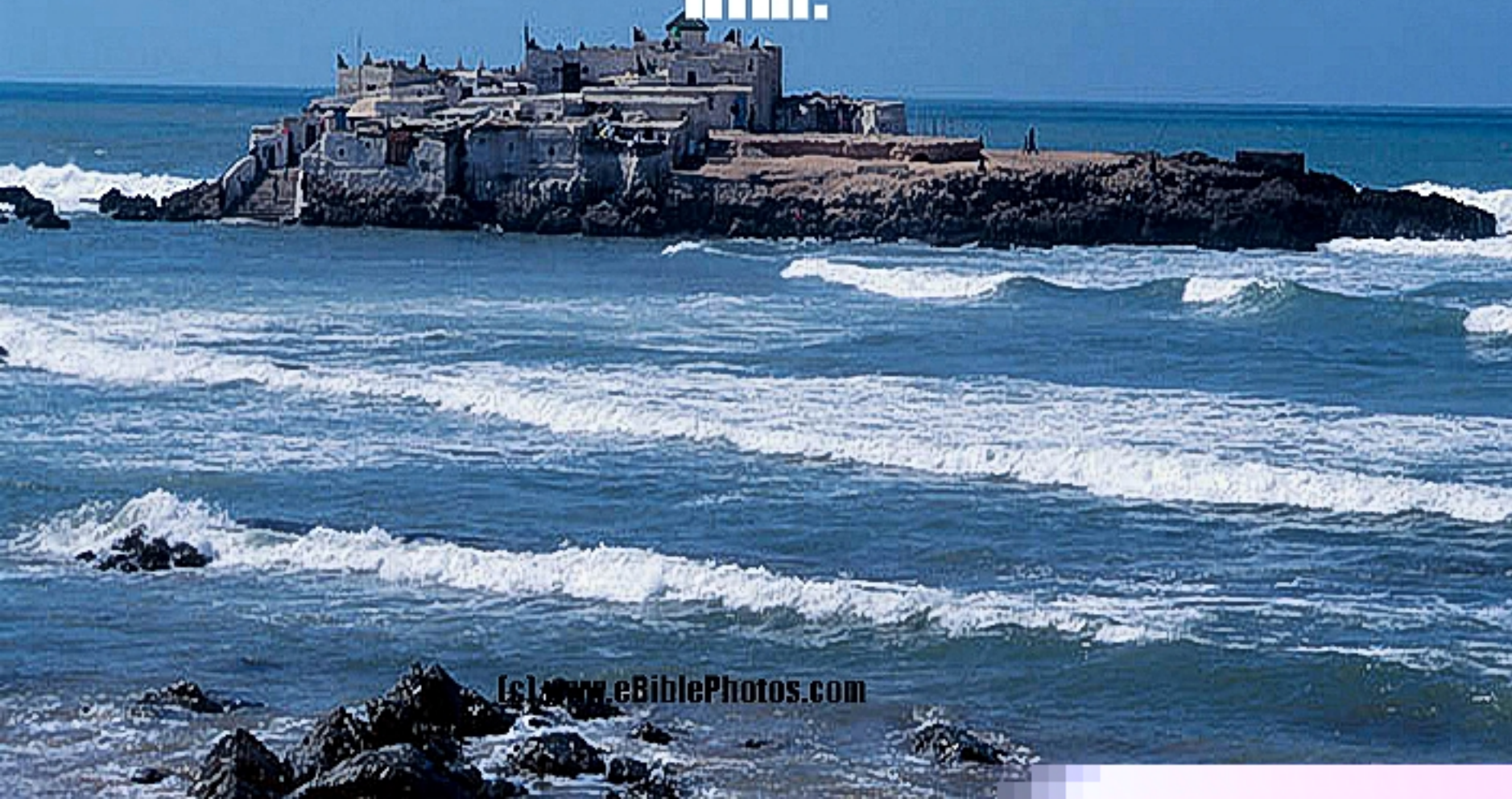


Word Study for --- ESAU'S



Gen 25:26 And after that came his brother out, and his hand took hold on Esau's heel; and his name was called Jacob: and Isaac was threescore years old when she bare them.

**Gen 27:23 And he discerned him not,
because his hands were hairy, as his
brother Esau's hands: so he blessed
him.**
