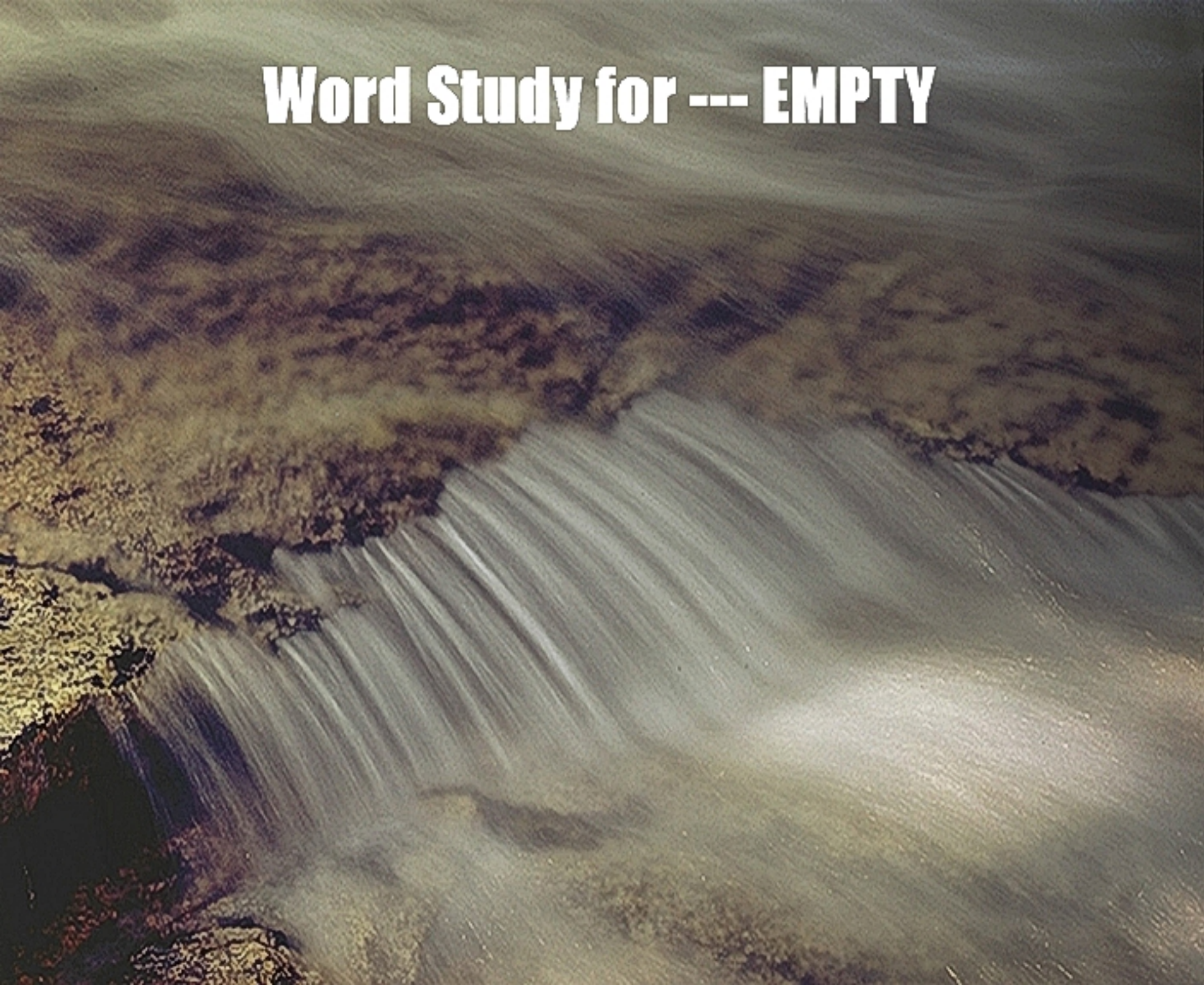






**Gen 31:42 Except the God of my father,
