

**Gen 31:42 Except the God of my father,  
the God of Abraham, and the fear of  
Isaac, had been with me, surely thou  
hadst sent me away now empty. God  
hath seen mine affliction and the  
labour of my hands, and rebuked thee  
yesternight.**

**Gen 37:24 And they took him, and cast  
him into a pit: and the pit was empty,  
there was no water in it.**

**Gen 41:27 And the seven thin and ill favoured kine that came up after them are seven years; and the seven empty ears blasted with the east wind shall be seven years of famine.**

**Exo 03:21 And I will give this people  
favour in the sight of the Egyptians:  
and it shall come to pass, that, when  
ye go, ye shall not go empty:**

**Exo 23:15 Thou shalt keep the feast of unleavened bread: I thou shalt eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded thee, in the time appointed of the month Abib; for in it thou camest out from Egypt: and none shall appear before me empty:]**

**Exo 34:20 But the firstling of an ass  
thou shalt redeem with a lamb: and if

yesterday, nor to day?**


**2Sa 01:22 From the blood of the slain,

they have made goodly images.**


