

# Word Study for --- ESTIMATION




**Lev 05:15 If a soul commit a trespass,  
and sin through ignorance, in the holy  
things of the LORD; then he shall bring  
for his trespass unto the LORD a ram  
without blemish out of the flocks, with  
thy estimation by shekels of silver,  
after the shekel of the sanctuary, for a  
trespass offering:**



**Lev 05:18 And he shall bring a ram without blemish out of the flock, with thy estimation, for a trespass offering, unto the priest: and the priest shall make an atonement for him concerning his ignorance wherein he erred and wist (it) not, and it shall be forgiven him.**




**Lev 27:02 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When a man shall make a singular vow, the persons [shall be] for the LORD by thy estimation.**

**Lev 27:03 And thy estimation shall be of the male from twenty years old even unto sixty years old, even thy estimation shall be fifty shekels of silver, after the shekel of the sanctuary.**

**Lev 27:04 And if it [be] a female, then  
thy estimation shall be thirty shekels.**

shekels, and for the female ten shekels.**


**Lev 27:06 And if lit bel from a month  
old even unto five years old, then thy  
estimation shall be of the male five  
shekels of silver, and for the female  
thy estimation lshall bel three  
shekels of silver.**

**Lev 27:07 And if lit bel from sixty years old and above; if lit bel a male, then thy estimation shall be fifteen shekels, and for the female ten shekels.**

**Lev 27:08 But if he be poorer than thy estimation, then he shall present himself before the priest, and the priest shall value him; according to his ability that vowed shall the priest value him.**



**Lev 27:13 But if he will at all redeem it,  
then he shall add a fifth part thereof  
unto thy estimation.**




**Lev 27:15 And if he that sanctified it will  
redeem his house, then he shall add  
the fifth part of the money of thy  
estimation unto it, and it shall be his.**




**Lev 27:16 And if a man shall sanctify  
unto the LORD [some part] of a field of  
his possession, then thy estimation  
shall be according to the seed thereof:  
an homer of barley seed [shall be  
valued] at fifty shekels of silver.**


**Lev 27:17 If he sanctify his field from  
the year of jubilee, according to thy  
estimation it shall stand.**



**Lev 27:18 But if he sanctify his field after the jubilee, then the priest shall reckon unto him the money according to the years that remain, even unto the year of the jubilee, and it shall be abated from thy estimation.**

sold according to thy estimation.**

**Num 18:16 And those that are to be redeemed from a month old shalt thou redeem, according to thine estimation, for the money of five shekels, after the shekel of the sanctuary, which list twenty gerahs.**
