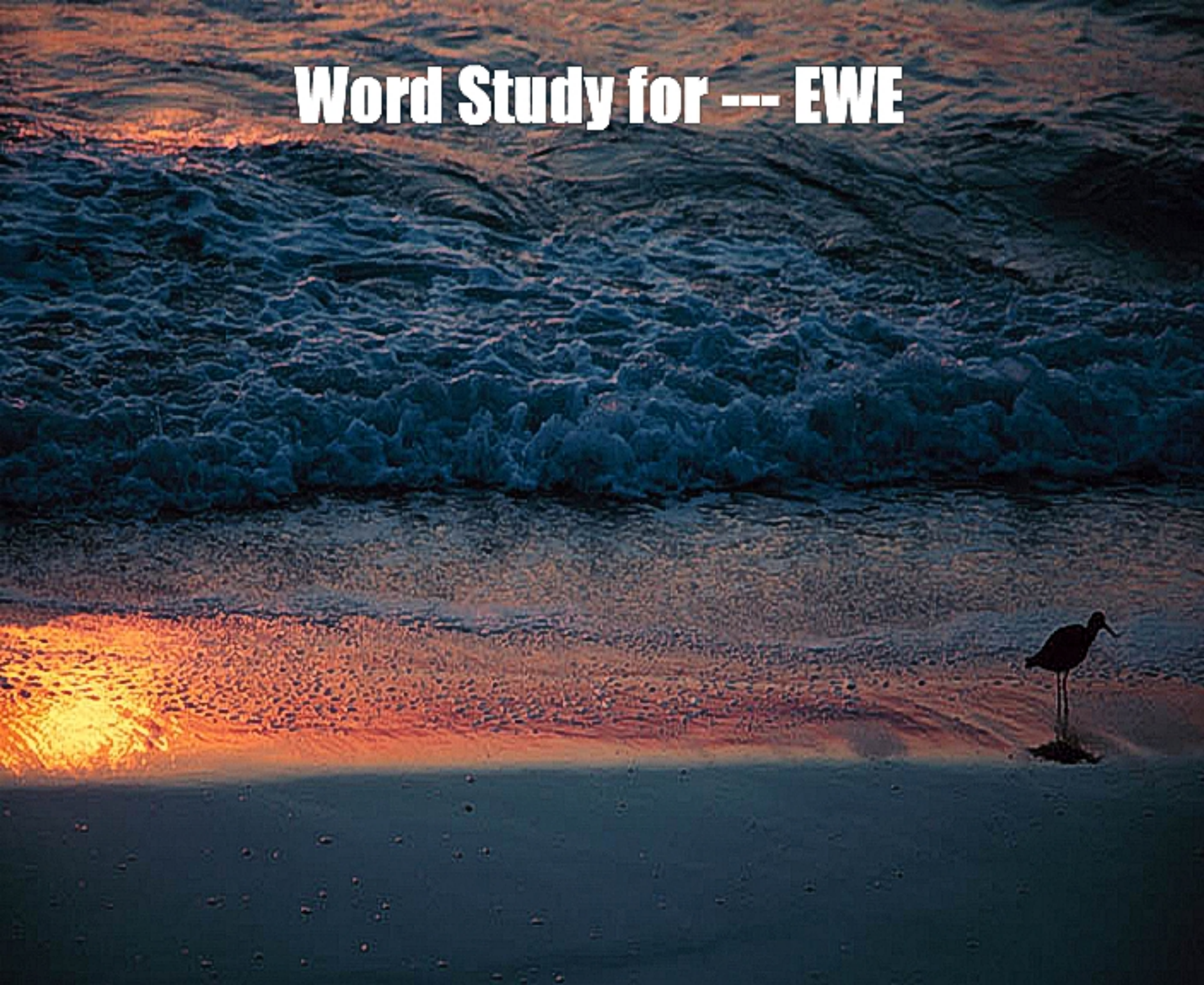



Gen 21:29 And Abimelech said unto Abraham, What mean these seven ewe lambs which thou hast set by themselves?


**Gen 21:30 And he said, For these seven
