

**1Sa 11:01 Then Nahash the Ammonite
came up, and encamped against
Jabesh-gilead: and all the men of Jabesh
said unto Nahash, Make a covenant with
us, and we will serve thee.**

1Sa 11:10 Therefore the men of Jabesh said, To morrow we will come out unto you, and ye shall do with us all that seemeth good unto you.



Jabesh, and fasted seven days.**




**2Ki 15:10 And Shallum the son of
