


Word Study for ---- JUEL



Jud 04:17 Howbeit Sisera fled away on his feet to the tent of Jael the wife of Heber the Kenite: for there was peace between Jabin the king of Hazor and the house of Heber the Kenite.

Jud 04:18 And Jael went out to meet Sisera, and said unto him, Turn in, my lord, turn in to me; fear not And when he had turned in unto her into the tent, she covered him with a mantle.

Jud 04:21 Then Jael Heber's wife took a nail of the tent, and took an hammer in her hand, and went softly unto him, and smote the nail into his temples, and fastened it into the ground: for he was fast asleep and weary. So he died.
