

**Exo 18:02 Then Jethro, Moses' father in law, took Zipporah, Moses' wife, after he had sent her back,**


**Exo 18:05 And Jethro, Moses' father in law, came with his sons and his wife unto Moses into the wilderness, where he encamped at the mount of God:**
