
Word Study for -- IOAB'S

**2Sa 14:30 Therefore he said unto his
servants, See, Joab's field is near
mine, and he hath barley there; go and
set it on fire. And Absalom's servants
set the field on fire.**

**2Sa 17:25 And Absalom made Amasa
captain of the host instead of Joab:
which Amasa was a man's son, whose
name was Ithra an Israelite, that went
in to Abigail the daughter of Nahash,
sister to Zeruiah Joab's mother.**

2Sa 18:02 And David sent forth a third part of the people under the hand of Joab, and a third part under the hand of Abishai the son of Zeruiah, Joab's brother, and a third part under the hand of Ittai the Gittite. And the king said unto the people, I will surely go forth with you myself also.

**2Sa 18:15 And ten young men that bare
Joab's armour compassed about and
smote Absalom, and slew him.**



2Sa 20:07 And there went out after him Joab's men, and the Cherethites, and the Pelethites, and all the mighty men: and they went out of Jerusalem, to pursue after Sheba the son of Bichri.

2Sa 20:08 When they were at the great stone which is in Gibeon, Amasa went before them. And Joab's garment that he had put on was girded unto him, and upon it a girdle with a sword fastened upon his loins in the sheath thereof; and as he went forth it fell out.

2Sa 20:10 But Amasa took no heed to the sword that [was] in Joab's hand: so he smote him therewith in the fifth [rib], and shed out his bowels to the ground, and struck him not again; and he died. So Joab and Abishai his brother pursued after Sheba the son of Bichri.

2Sa 20:11 And one of Joab's men stood by him, and said, He that favoureth Joab, and he that is for David, let him go after Joab.
