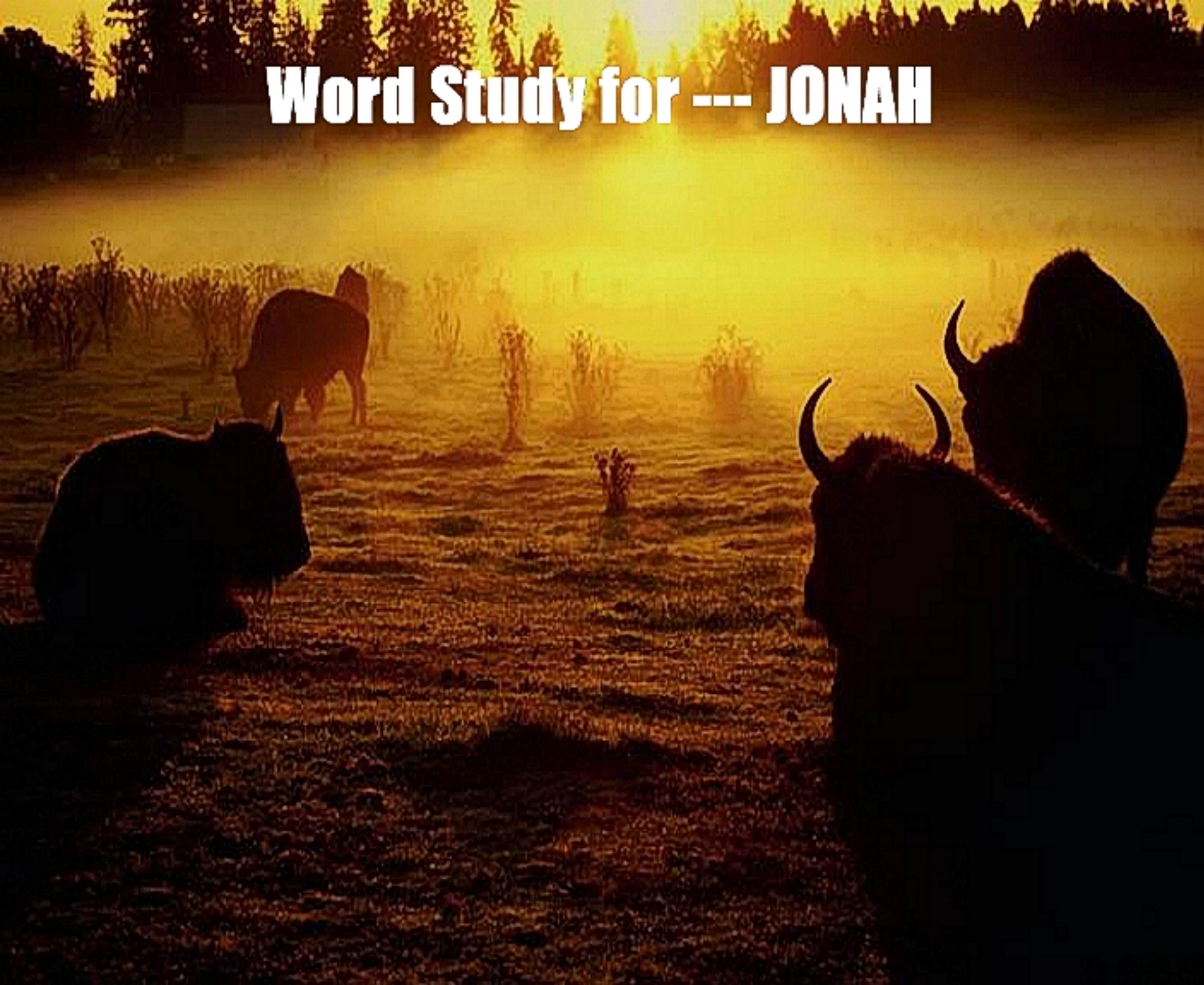

# Word Study for --- JONAH




**2Ki 14:25 He restored the coast of Israel from the entering of Hamath unto the sea of the plain, according to the word of the LORD God of Israel, which he spake by the hand of his servant Jonah, the son of Amittai, the prophet, which [was] of Gathhepher.**

**Jon 01:01 Now the word of the LORD  
came unto Jonah the son of Amittai,  
saying,**




**Jon 01:03 But Jonah rose up to flee  
unto Tarshish from the presence of  
the LORD, and went down to Joppa; and  
he found a ship going to Tarshish: so  
he paid the fare thereof, and went  
down into it, to go with them unto  
Tarshish from the presence of the  
LORD.**


**Jon 03:04 And Jonah began to enter

**Jon 04:01 But it displeased Jonah exceedingly, and he was very angry.**


