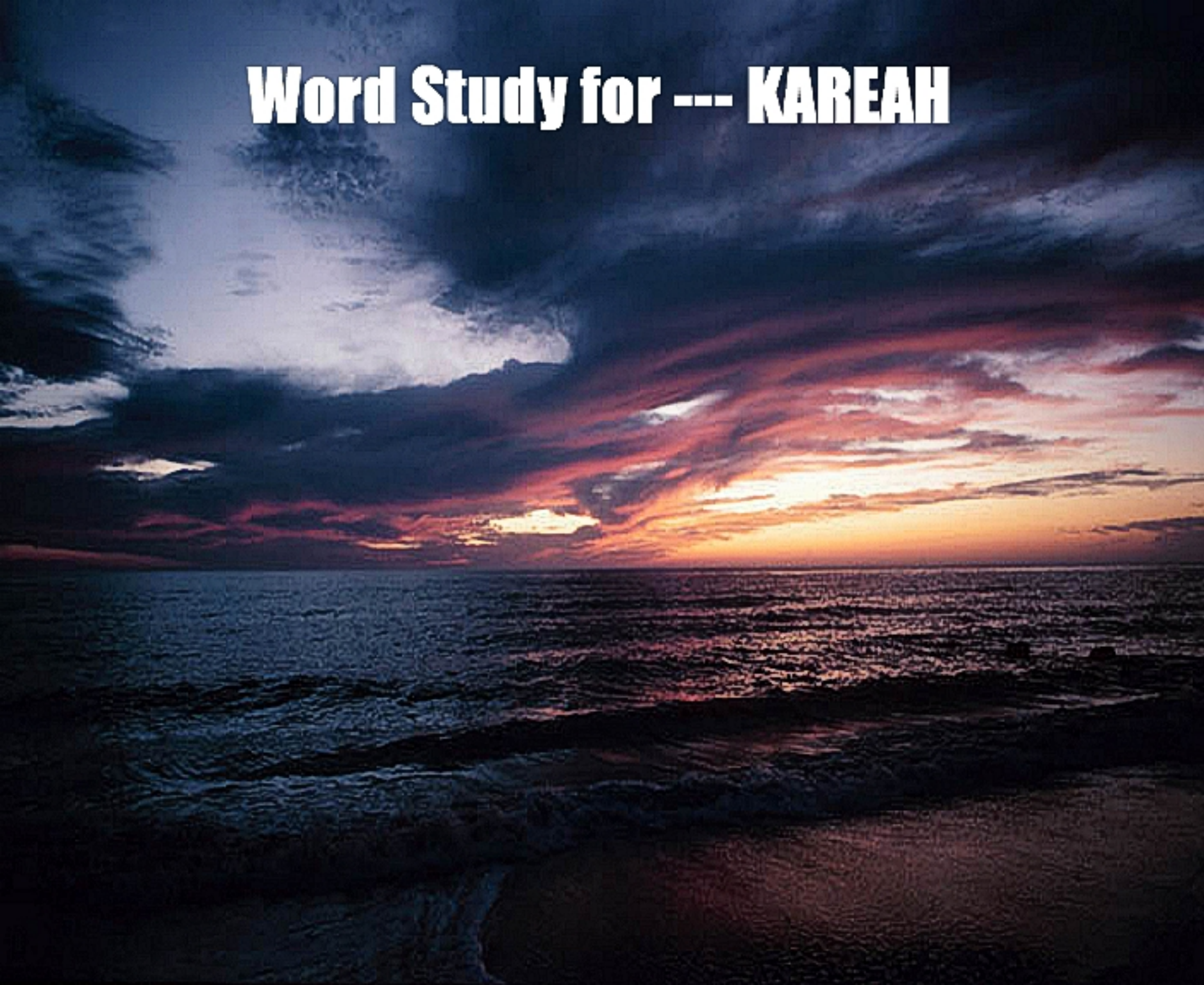


Jer 40:13 Moreover Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces that I were) in the fields, came to Gedaliah to Mizpah,






