


**2Ki 23:04 And the king commanded

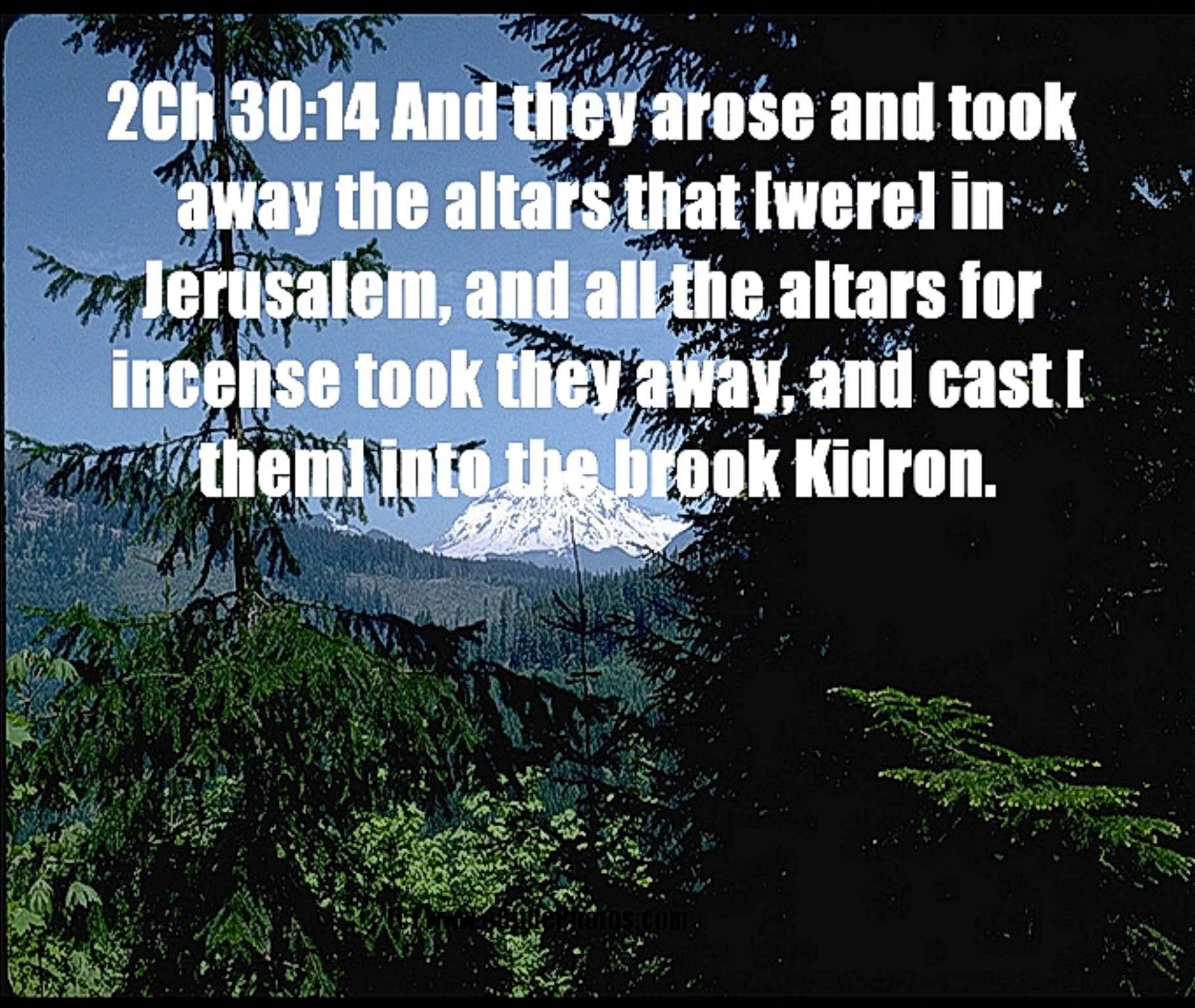


