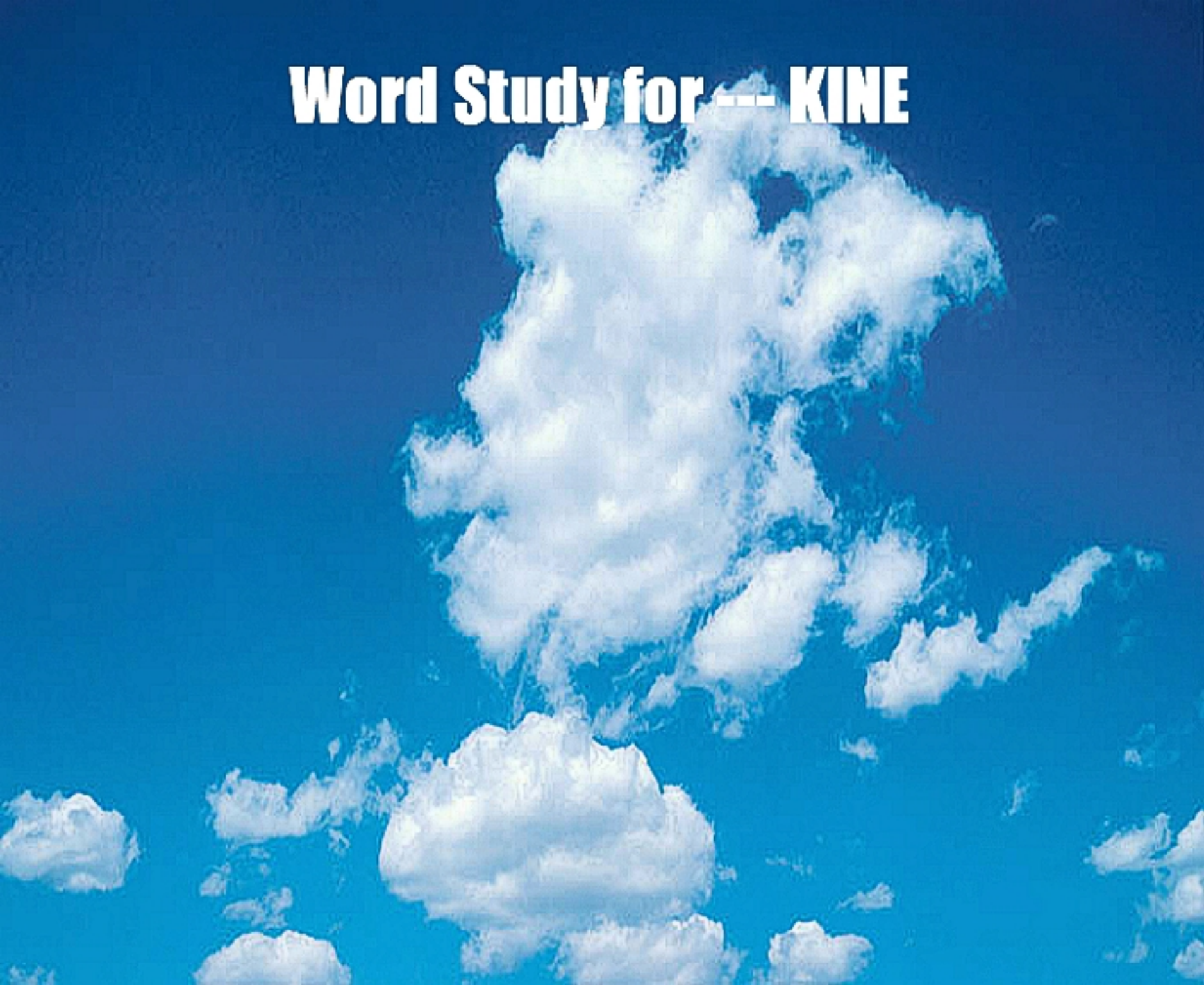

twenty she asses, and ten foals.**

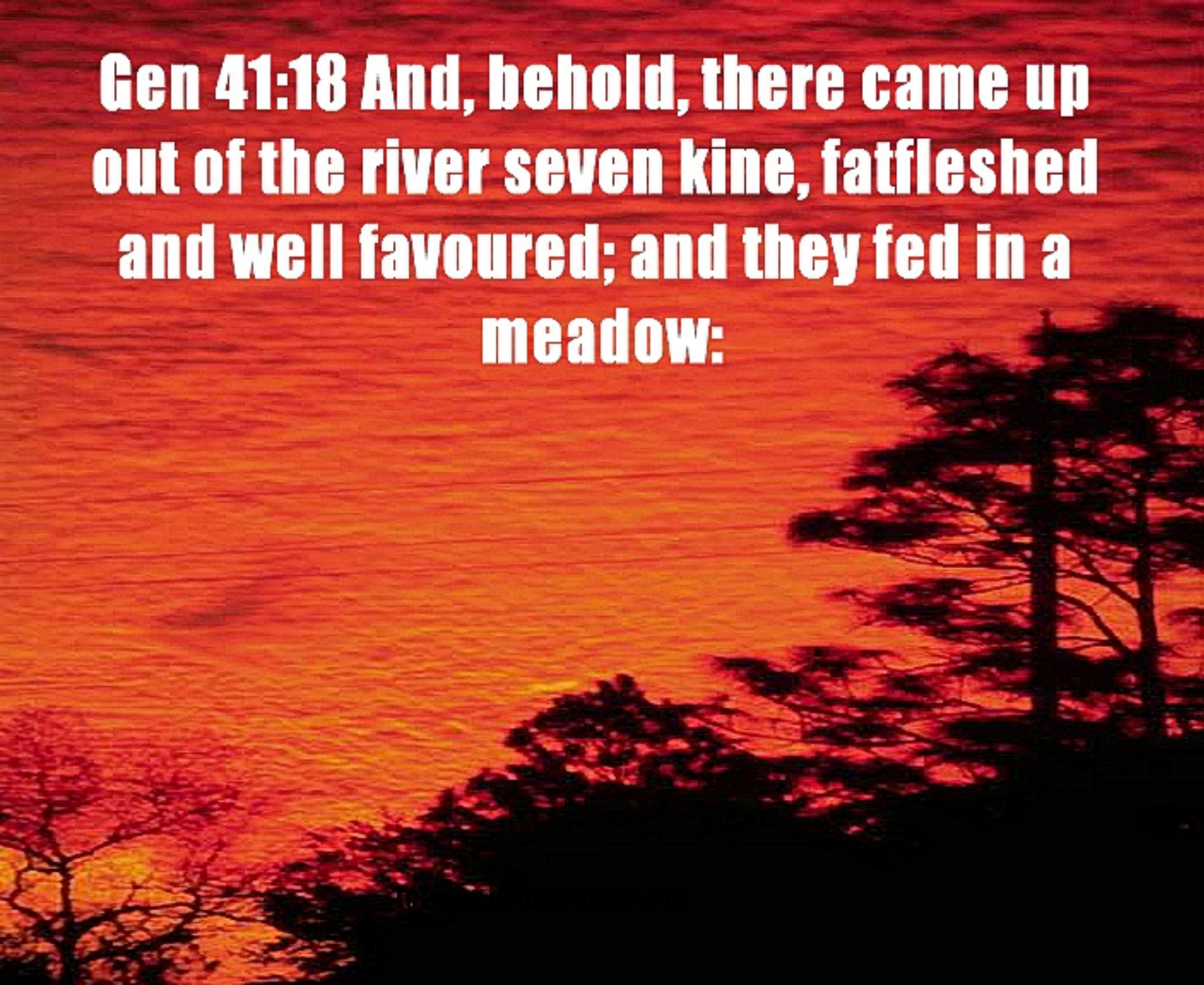
**Gen 41:02 And, behold, there came up




