Word Study for --- MEGIDDO



**Jos 12:21 The king of Taanach, one; the
king of Megiddo, one;**



**Jos 17:11 And Manasseh had in
Issachar and in Asher Bethshean and
her towns, and Ibleam and her towns,
and the inhabitants of Dor and her
towns, and the inhabitants of Endor
and her towns, and the inhabitants of
Taanach and her towns, and the
inhabitants of Megiddo and her towns,
[even] three countries.**

**Jud 01:27 Neither did Manasseh drive
out [the inhabitants of] Bethshean and
her towns, nor Taanach and her towns,
nor the inhabitants of Dor and her
towns, nor the inhabitants of Ibleam
and her towns, nor the inhabitants of
Megiddo and her towns: but the
Canaanites would dwell in that land.**

**Jud 05:19 The kings came [and] fought,
then fought the kings of Canaan in
Taanach by the waters of Megiddo;
they took no gain of money.**

**1Ki 04:12 Baana the son of Ahilud; to
him pertained Taanach and Megiddo,
and all Bethshean, which is by Zartanah
beneath Jezreel, from Bethshean to
Abelmeholah, even unto the place that
is beyond Jokneam:**

**1Ki 09:15 And this [is] the reason of the
levy which king Solomon raised; for to
build the house of the LORD, and his
own house, and Millo, and the wall of
Jerusalem, and Hazor, and Megiddo,
and Gezer.**

2Ki 09:27 But when Ahaziah the king of Judah saw [this], he fled by the way of the garden house. And Jehu followed after him, and said, Smite him also in the chariot [And they did so] at the going up to Gur, which [is] by Ibleam. And he fled to Megiddo, and died there.

**2Ki 23:29 In his days Pharaohnechoh
king of Egypt went up against the king
of Assyria to the river Euphrates: and
king Josiah went against him; and he
slew him at Megiddo, when he had
seen him.**

**2Ki 23:30 And his servants carried him
in a chariot dead from Megiddo, and
brought him to Jerusalem, and buried
him in his own sepulchre. And the
people of the land took Jehoahaz the
son of Josiah, and anointed him, and
made him king in his father's stead.**



**1Ch 07:29 And by the borders of the
children of Manasseh, Bethshean and
her towns, Taanach and her towns,
Megiddo and her towns, Dor and her
towns. In these dwelt the children of
Joseph the son of Israel.**

**2Ch 35:22 Nevertheless Josiah would
not turn his face from him, but
disguised himself, that he might fight
with him, and hearkened not unto the
words of Necho from the mouth of God,
and came to fight in the valley of
Megiddo.**
