

**2Sa 04:04 And Jonathan, Saul's son, had a son that was lame of his feet. He was five years old when the tidings came of Saul and Jonathan out of Jezreel, and his nurse took him up, and fled: and it came to pass, as she made haste to flee, that he fell, and became lame. And his name was Mephibosheth.**


**2Sa 09:11 Then said Ziba unto the king,


**2Sa 09:13 So Mephibosheth dwelt in


