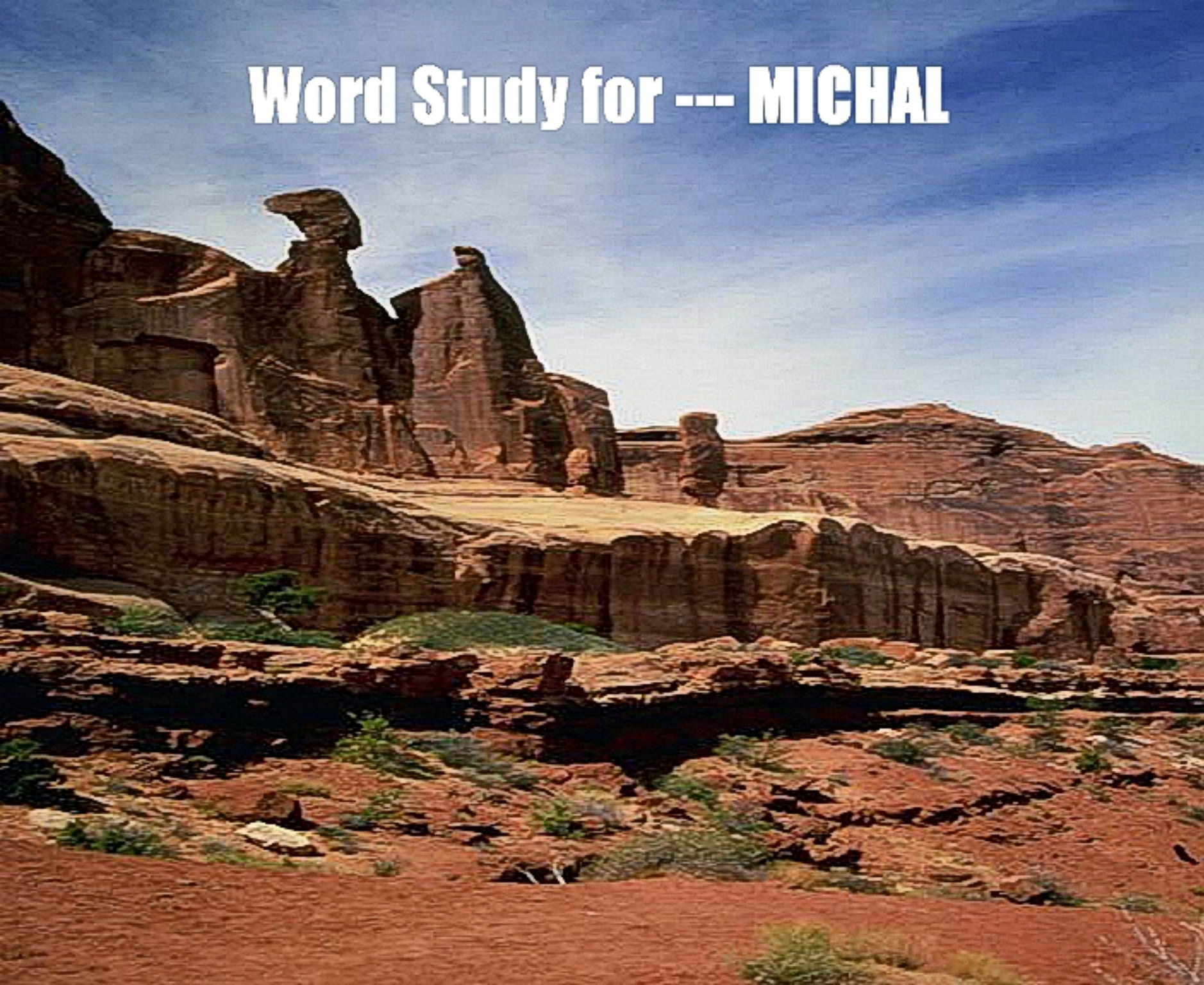



Michal Saul's daughter loved him.**




