

**Psa 123:02 Behold, as the eyes of

masters, [and] as the eyes of a maiden
unto the hand of her mistress; so our
eyes [wait] upon the LORD our God,
until that he have mercy upon us.**

**Pro 25:13 As the cold of snow in the

I Christ.**


**Luk 16:13 No servant can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other.
