

**Gen 43:34 And he took [and sent]  
messes unto them from before him:  
but Benjamin's mess was five times so  
much as any of theirs. And they drank,  
and were merry with him.**

**Jud 09:27 And they went out into the fields, and gathered their vineyards, and trode [the grapes], and made merry, and went into the house of their god, and did eat and drink, and cursed Abimelech.**

**Jud 16:25 And it came to pass, when  
their hearts were merry, that they said,  
Call for Samson, that he may make us  
sport. And they called for Samson out of  
the prison house; and he made them  
sport: and they set him between the  
pillars.**

**Jud 19:06 And they sat down, and did eat and drink both of them together: for the damsel's father had said unto the man, Be content, I pray thee, and tarry all night, and let thine heart be merry.**



heart; for God now accepteth thy works.**


**Ecc 10:19 A feast is made for laughter,
