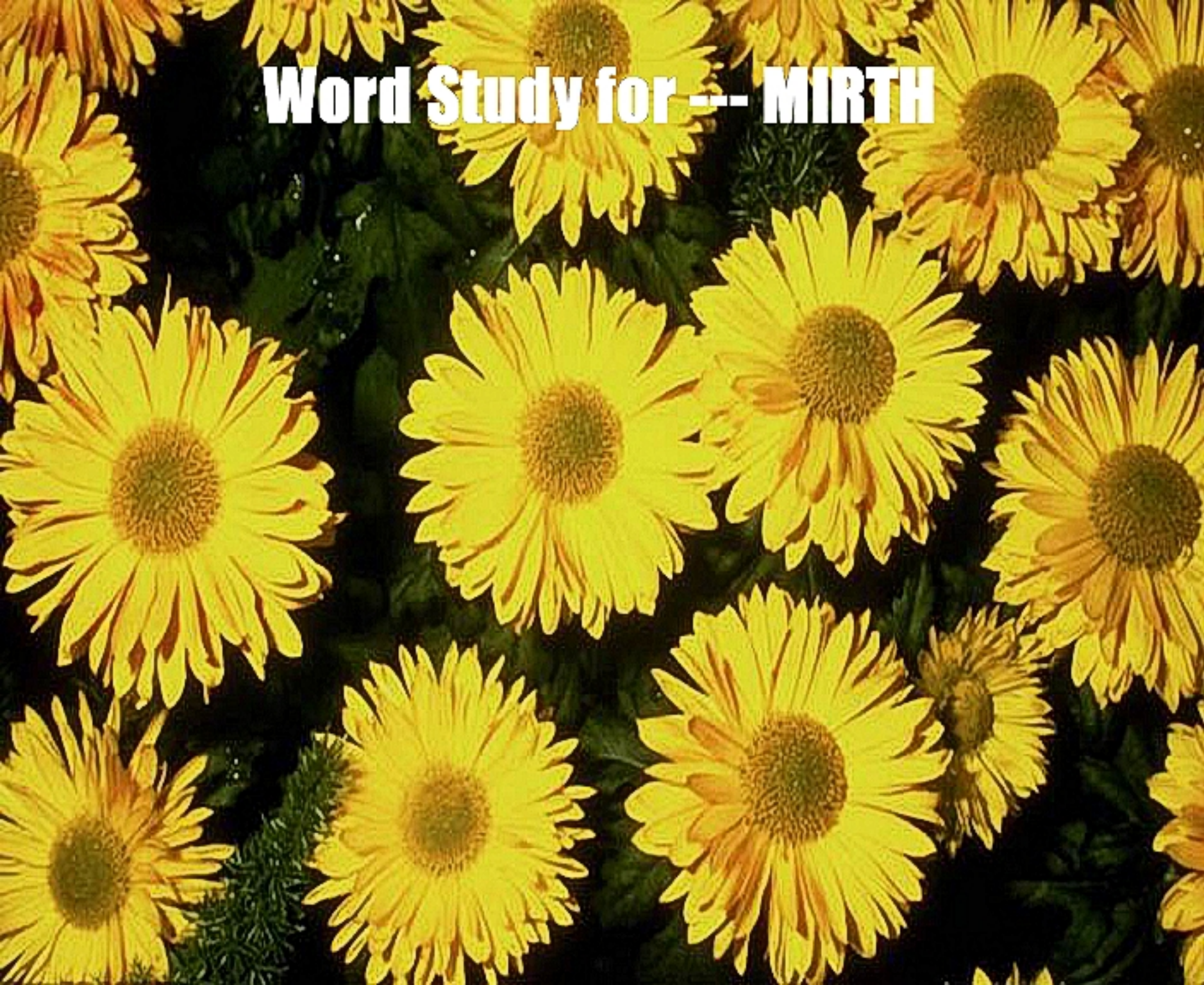



songs, with tabret, and with harp?**




**Neh 08:12 And all the people went




