

**Gen 37:34 And Jacob rent his clothes,
and put sackcloth upon his loins, and
mourned for his son many days.**

**Gen 50:03 And forty days were fulfilled
for him; for so are fulfilled the days of
those which are embalmed: and the
Egyptians mourned for him threescore
and ten days.**

Gen 50:10 And they came to the threshingfloor of Atad, which is beyond Jordan, and there they mourned with a great and very sore lamentation: and he made a mourning for his father seven days.

Exo 33:04 And when the people heard these evil tidings, they mourned: and no man did put on him his ornaments.

Num 14:39 And Moses told these sayings unto all the children of Israel; and the people mourned greatly.

Num 20:29 And when all the congregation saw that Aaron was dead, they mourned for Aaron thirty days, even all the house of Israel.

dead, she mourned for her husband.**

**2Sa 13:37 But Absalom fled, and went
to Talmai, the son of Ammihud, king of
Geshur. And [David] mourned for his
son every day.**

2Sa 14:02 And Joab sent to Tekoah, and fetched thence a wise woman, and said unto her, I pray thee, feign thyself to be a mourner, and put on now mourning apparel, and anoint not thyself with oil; but be as a woman that had a long time mourned for the dead:

1Ki 13:30 And he laid his carcase in his own grave; and they mourned over him, [saying], Alas, my brother!

1Ki 14:18 And they buried him; and all Israel mourned for him, according to the word of the LORD, which he spake by the hand of his servant Ahijah the prophet.

1Ch 07:22 And Ephraim their father mourned many days, and his brethren came to comfort him.
