

followed him.**




Mat 08:18 Now when Jesus saw great multitudes about him, he gave commandment to depart unto the other side.

Mat 09:36 But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.


Mat 11:07 And as they departed, Jesus began to say unto the multitudes concerning John, What went ye out into the wilderness to see? A reed shaken with the wind?



Mat 12:15 But when Jesus knew [it], he withdrew himself from thence: and great multitudes followed him, and he healed them all;




Mat 13:02 And great multitudes were gathered together unto him, so that he went into a ship, and sat; and the whole multitude stood on the shore.
