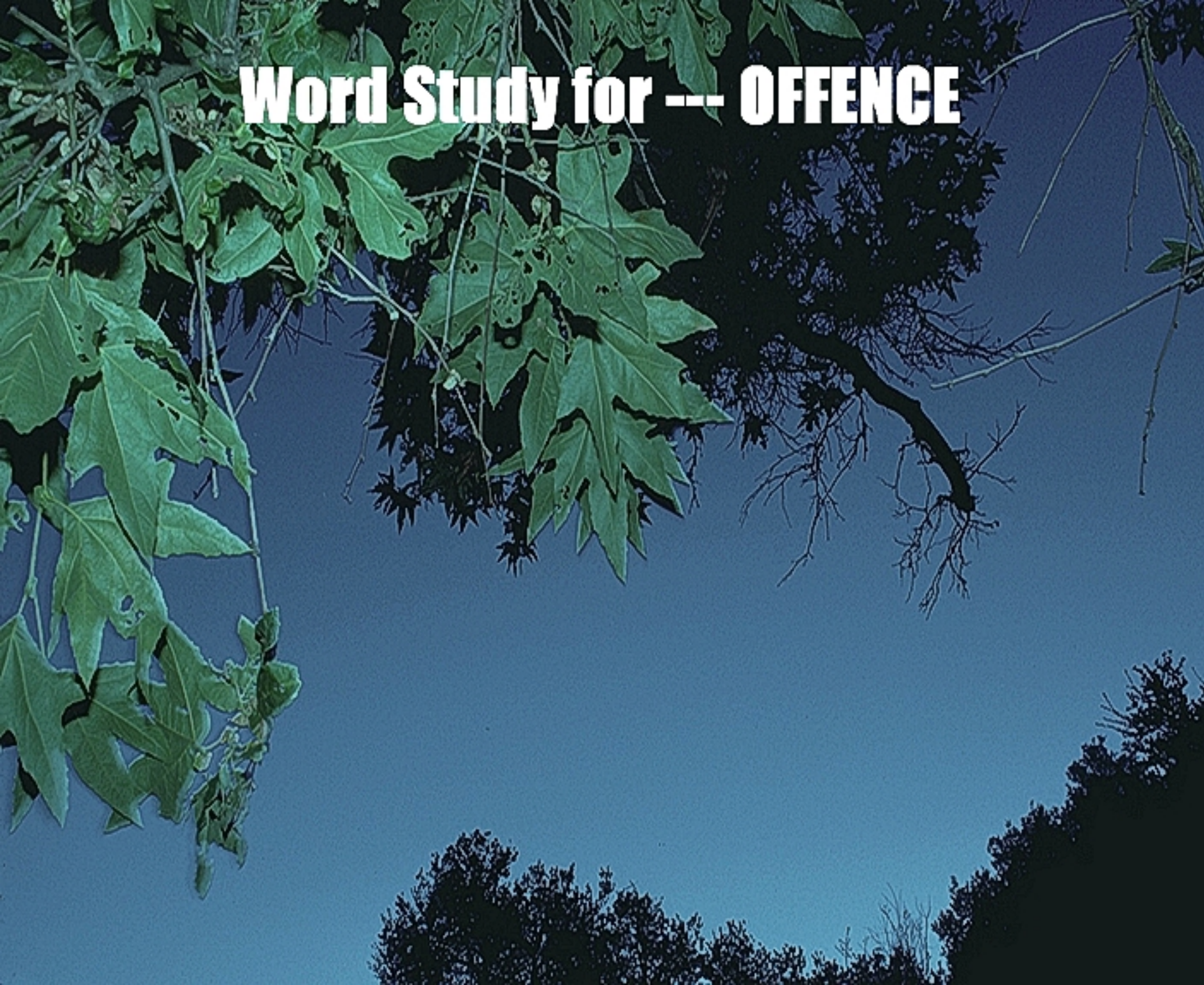




Word Study for --- OFFENCE






**1Sa 25:31 That this shall be no grief
unto thee, nor offence of heart unto my
lord, either that thou hast shed blood
causeless, or that my lord hath
avenged himself: but when the LORD
shall have dealt well with my lord, then
remember thine handmaid.**

**Isa 08:14 And he shall be for a

both the houses of Israel, for a gin and


**Mat 18:07 Woe unto the world because
