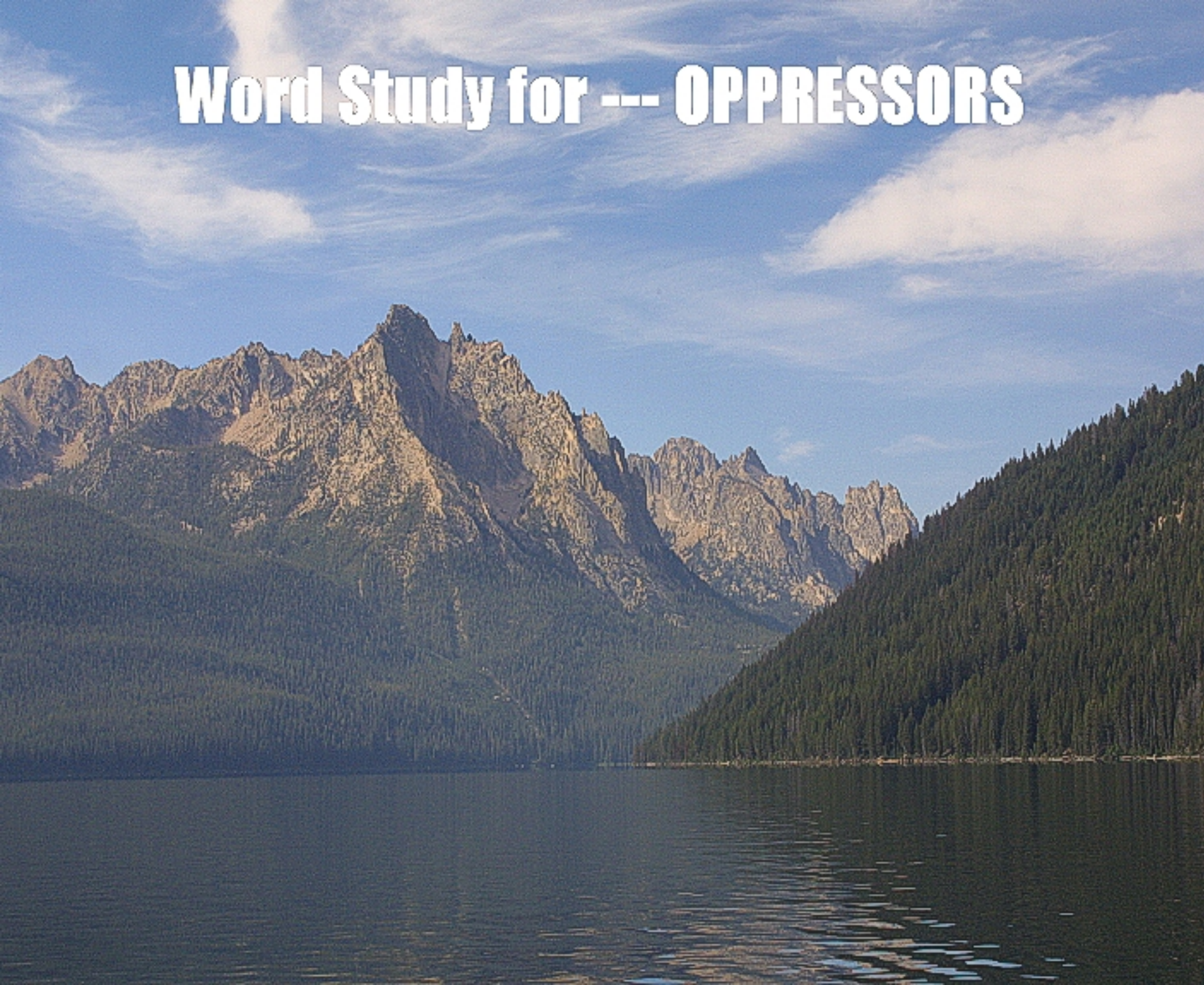




Job 27:13 This list the portion of a wicked man with God, and the heritage of oppressors, [which] they shall receive of the Almighty.


