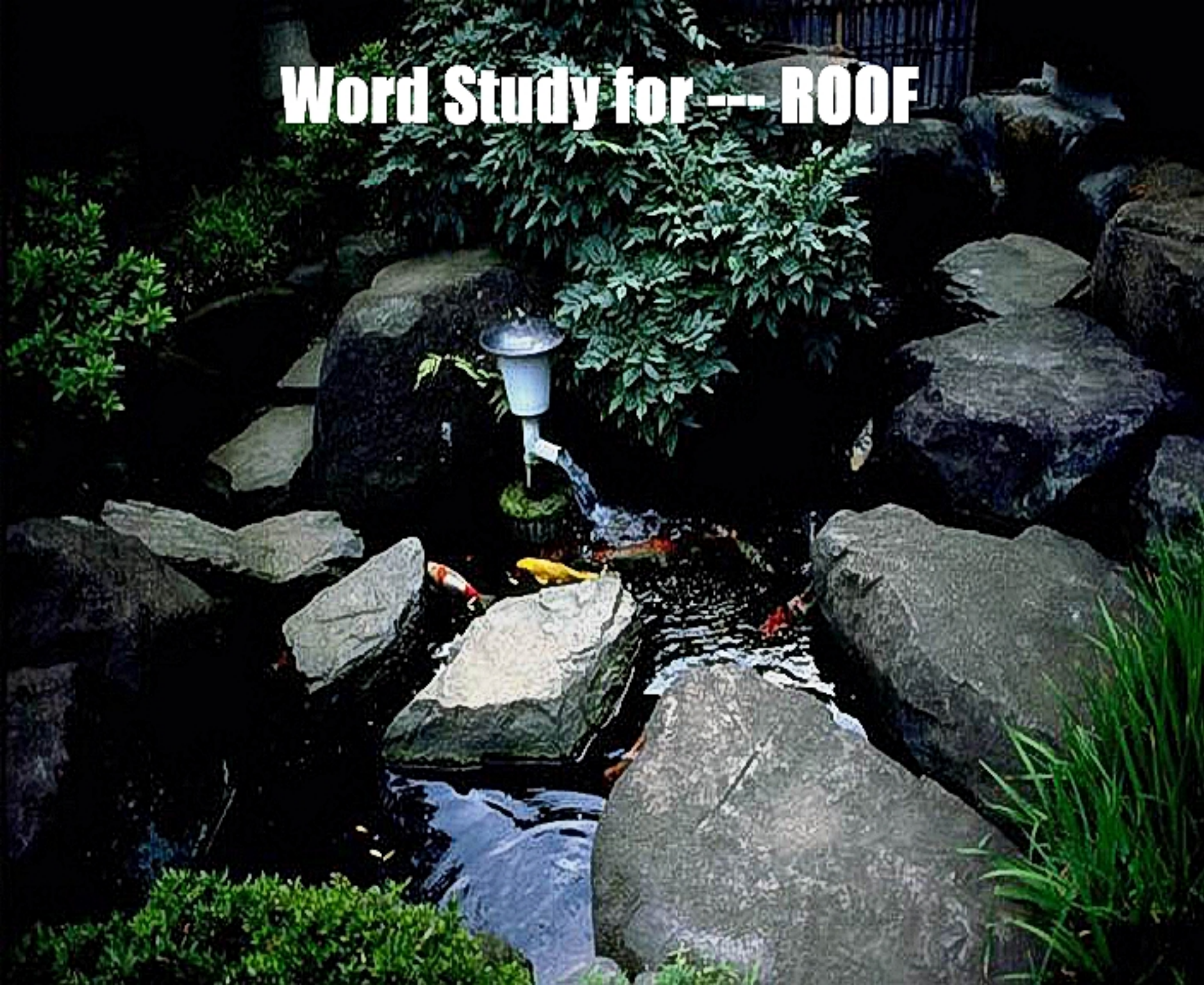



Deu 22:08 When thou buildest a new house, then thou shalt make a battlement for thy roof, that thou bring not blood upon thine house, if any man fall from thence.


Jos 02:06 But she had brought them up to the roof of the house, and hid them with the stalks of flax, which she had laid in order upon the roof.



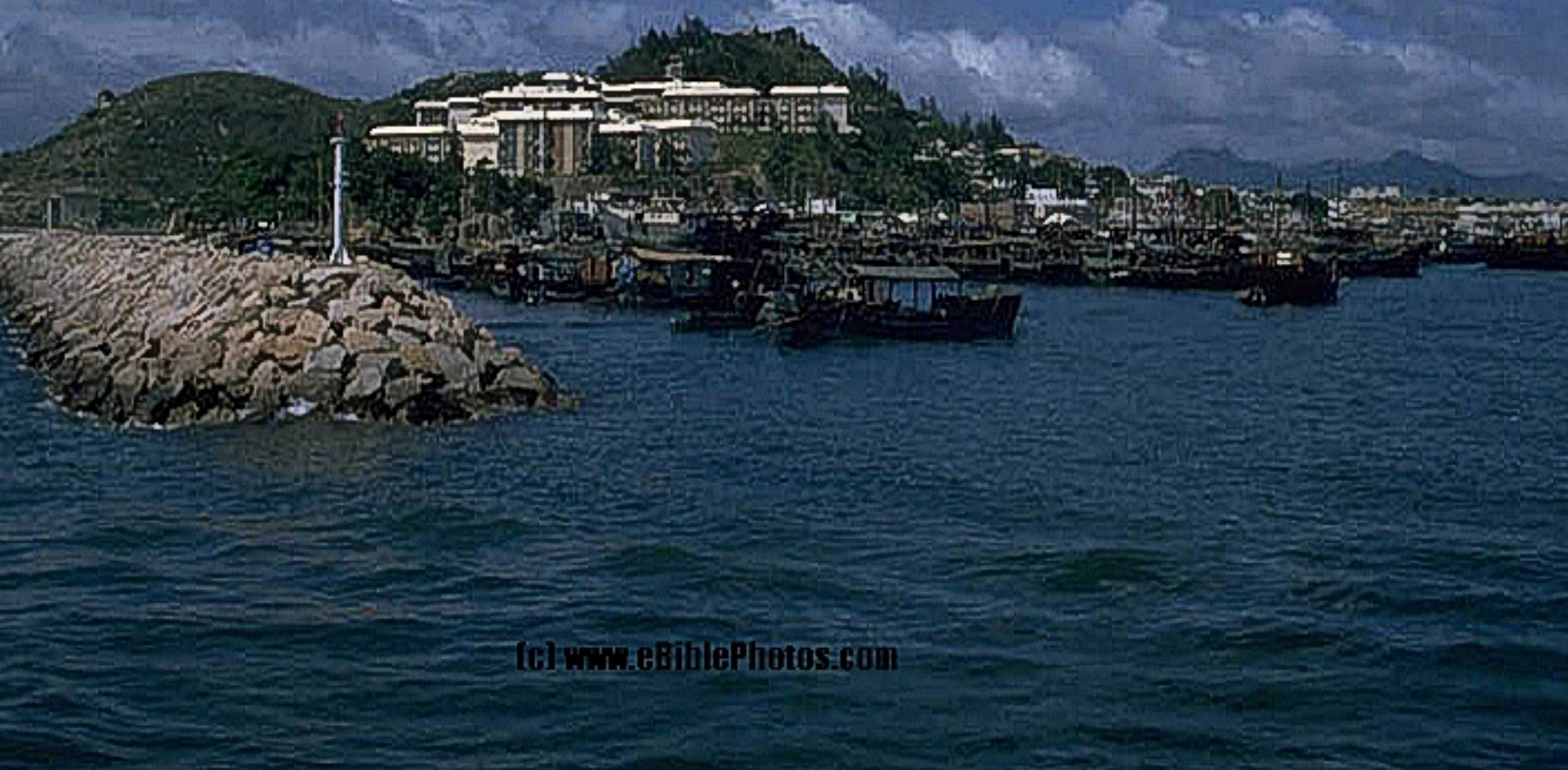


