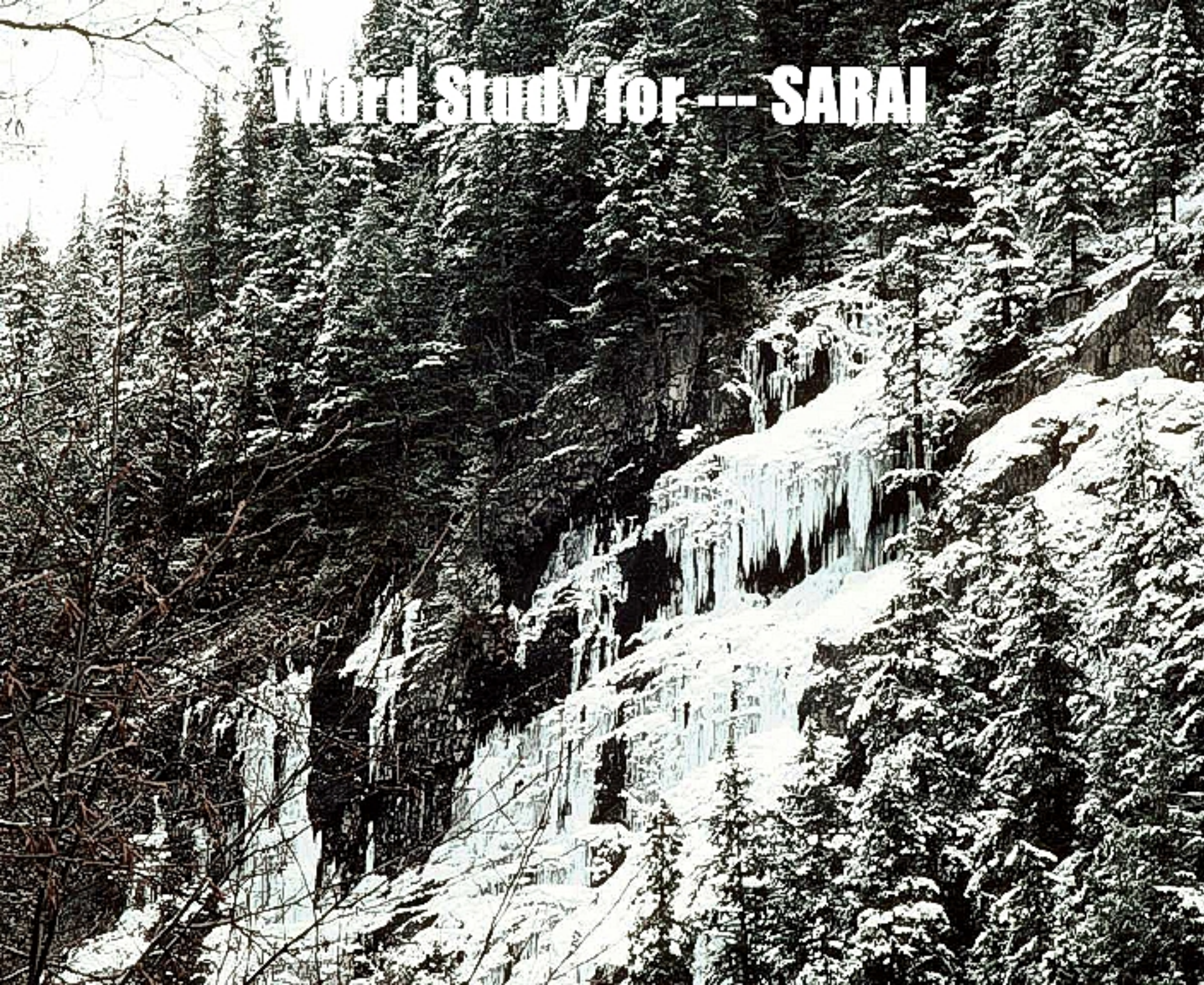



**Gen 11:30 But Sarai was barren; she had no child.**










**Gen 16:02 And Sarai said unto Abram,
