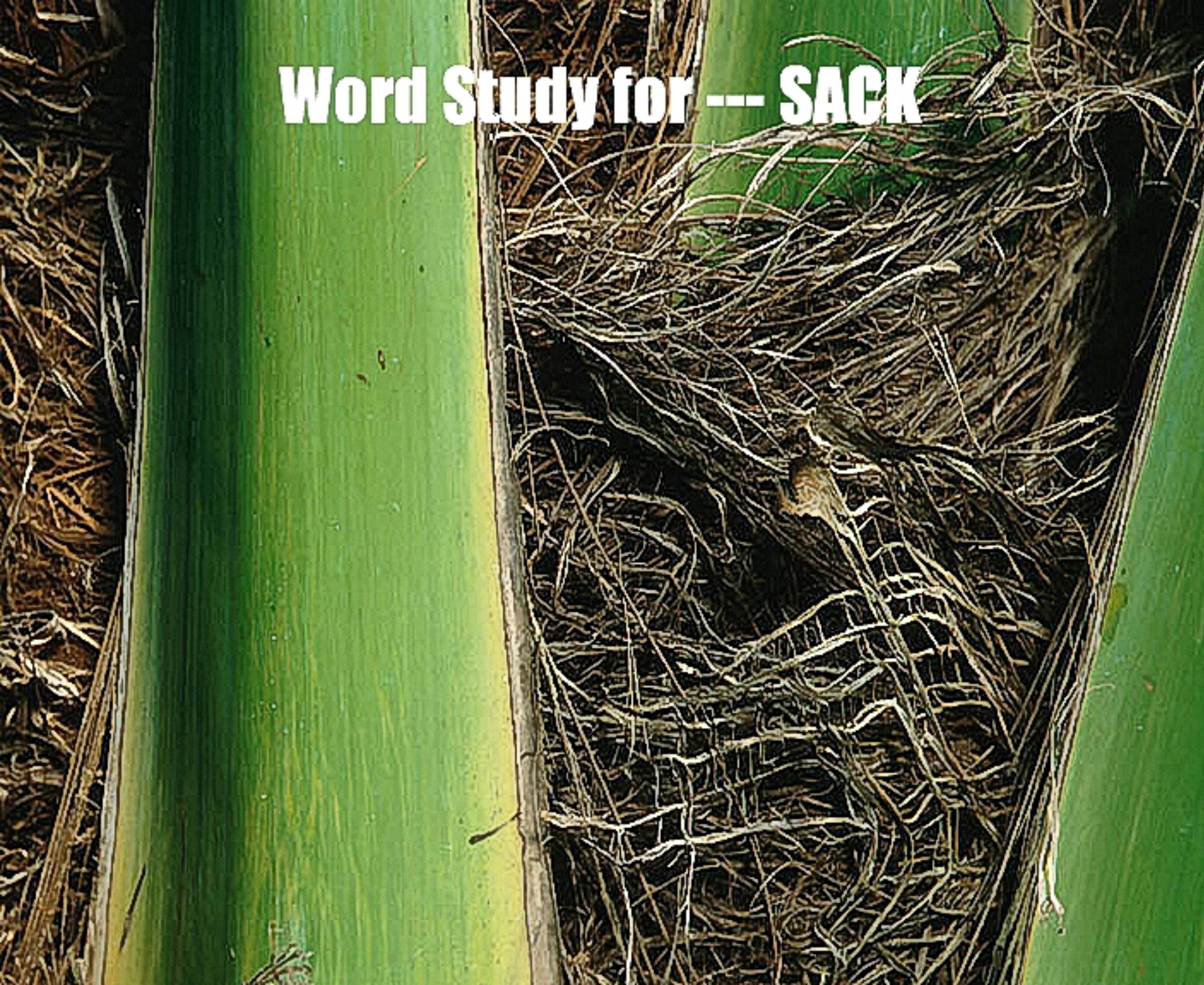


# Word Study for --- SACK


