

Word Study for --- SCOURGE



**Job 05:21 Thou shalt be hid from the
scourge of the tongue: neither shalt
thou be afraid of destruction when it
cometh.**



Job 09:23 If the scourge slay suddenly, he will laugh at the trial of the innocent



Isa 10:26 And the LORD of hosts shall stir up a scourge for him according to the slaughter of Midian at the rock of Oreb: and [as] his rod I wasl upon the sea, so shall he lift it up after the manner of Egypt.

**Isa 28:15 Because ye have said, We
have made a covenant with death, and
with hell are we at agreement; when
the overflowing scourge shall pass
through, it shall not come unto us; for
we have made lies our refuge, and
under falsehood have we hid
ourselves:**

**Isa 28:18 And your covenant with
death shall be disannulled, and your
agreement with hell shall not stand;
when the overflowing scourge shall
pass through, then ye shall be trodden
down by it.**

Mat 10:17 But beware of men: for they will deliver you up to the councils, and they will scourge you in their synagogues;

Mat 20:19 And shall deliver him to the Gentiles to mock, and to scourge, and to crucify [him]: and the third day he shall rise again.

Mat 23:34 Wherefore, behold, I send unto you prophets, and wise men, and scribes: and [some] of them ye shall kill and crucify; and [some] of them shall ye scourge in your synagogues, and persecute [them] from city to city:

**Mar 10:34 And they shall mock him,
and shall scourge him, and shall spit
upon him, and shall kill him: and the
third day he shall rise again.**

**Luk 18:33 And they shall scourge [him],
and put him to death: and the third day
he shall rise again.**

Joh 02:15 And when he had made a scourge of small cords, he drove them all out of the temple, and the sheep, and the oxen; and poured out the changers' money, and overthrew the tables;

**Act 22:25 And as they bound him with
thongs, Paul said unto the centurion
that stood by, Is it lawful for you to
scourge a man that is a Roman, and
uncondemned?**
