


**1Sa 09:09 [Beforetime in Israel, when
a man went to inquire of God, thus he
spake, Come, and let us go to the seer:
for [he that is] now [called] a Prophet
was beforetime called a Seer.]**

**1Sa 09:11 And as they went up the hill to
the city, they found young maidens
going out to draw water, and said unto
them, Is the seer here?**



**1Sa 09:19 And Samuel answered Saul,
and said, I [am] the seer: go up before
me unto the high place; for ye shall
eat with me to day, and to morrow I
will let thee go, and will tell thee all
that [is] in thine heart.**

**2Sa 15:27 The king said also unto Zadok
