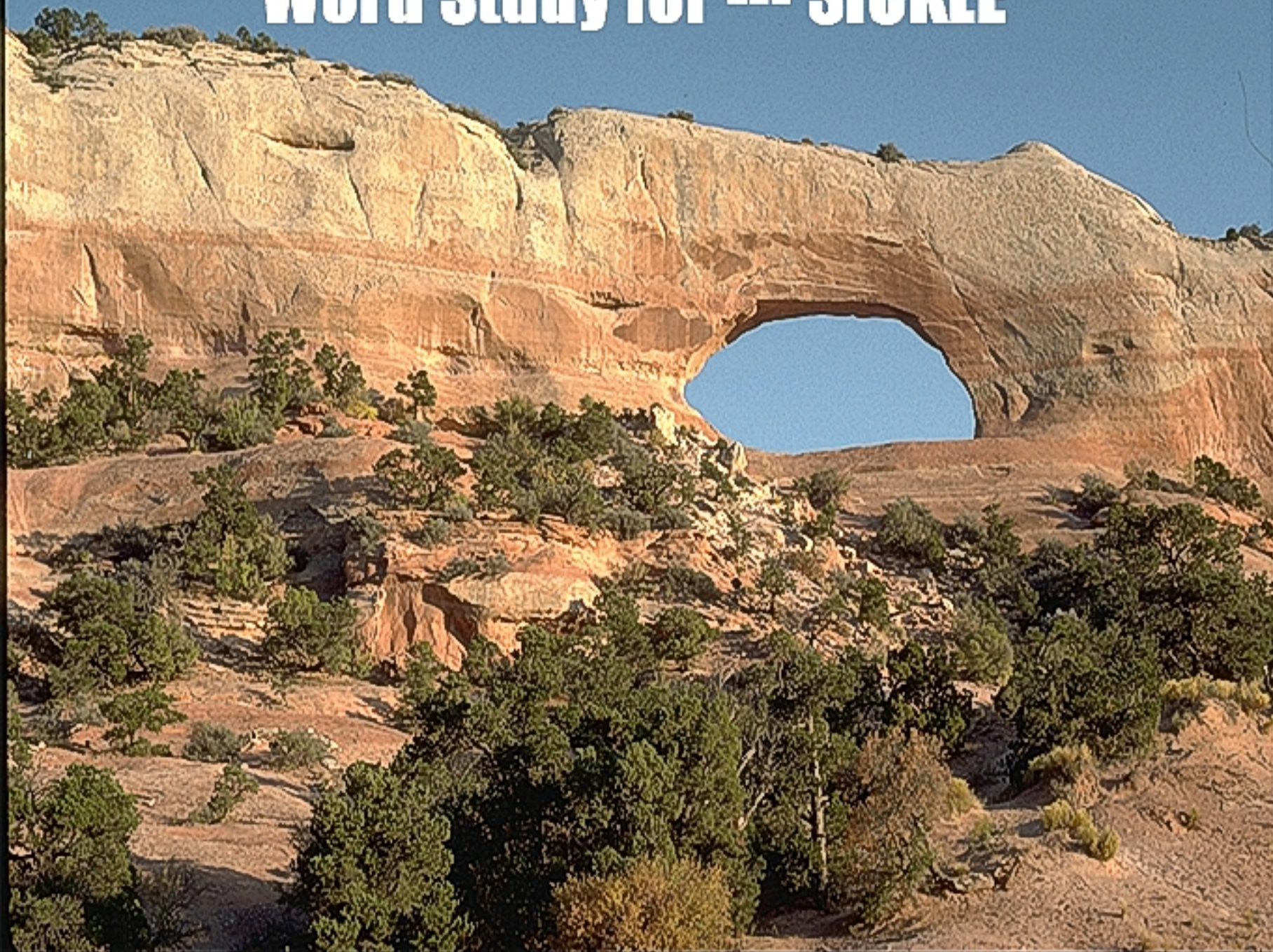



come.**






