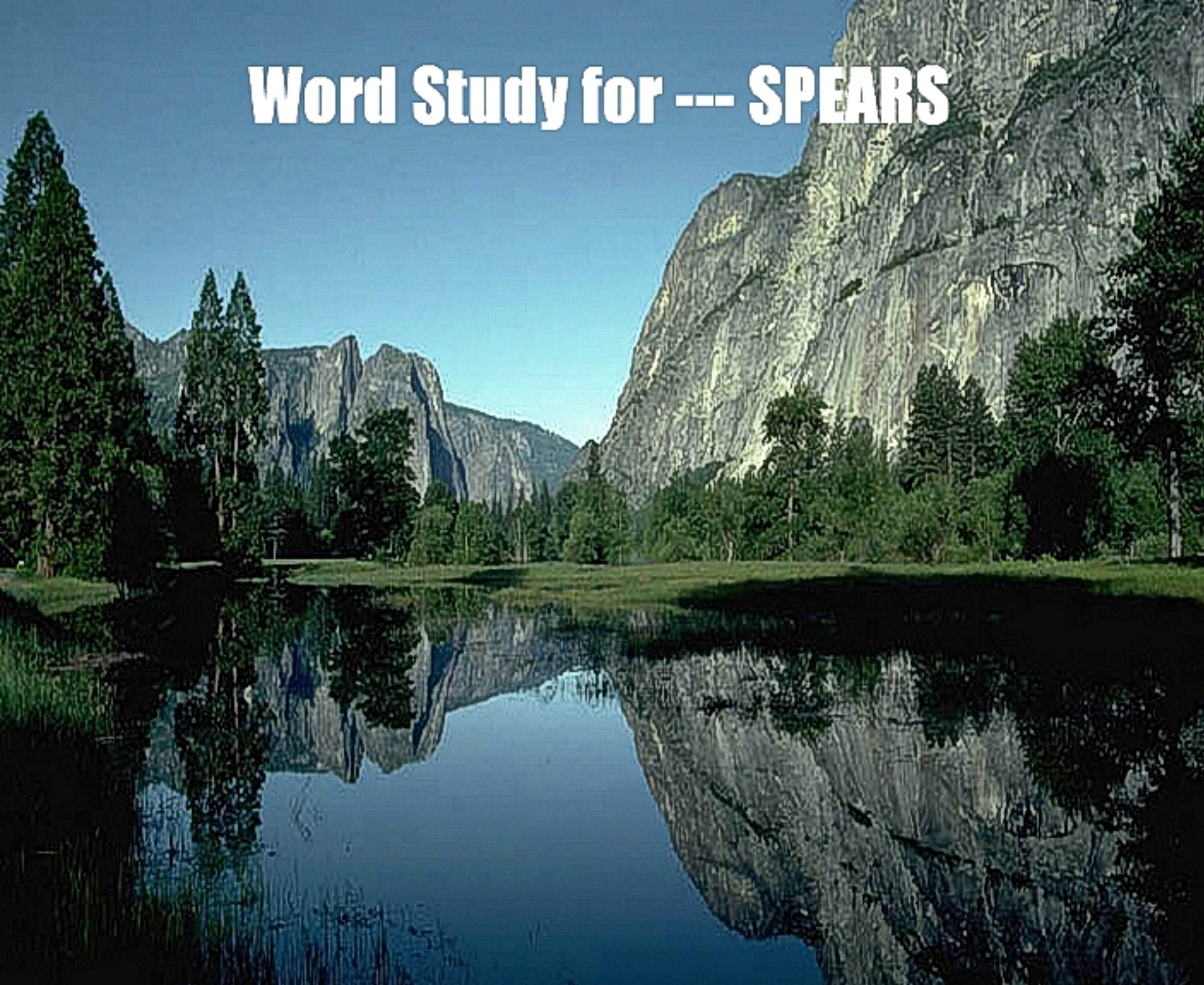


**1Sa 13:19 Now there was no smith found throughout all the land of Israel: for the Philistines said, Lest the Hebrews make them swords or spears:**

in the temple of the LORD.**




**2Ch 11:12 And in every several city he



**Neh 04:13 Therefore set I in the lower places behind the wall, [and] on the higher places, I even set the people after their families with their swords, their spears, and their bows.**





appeared.**





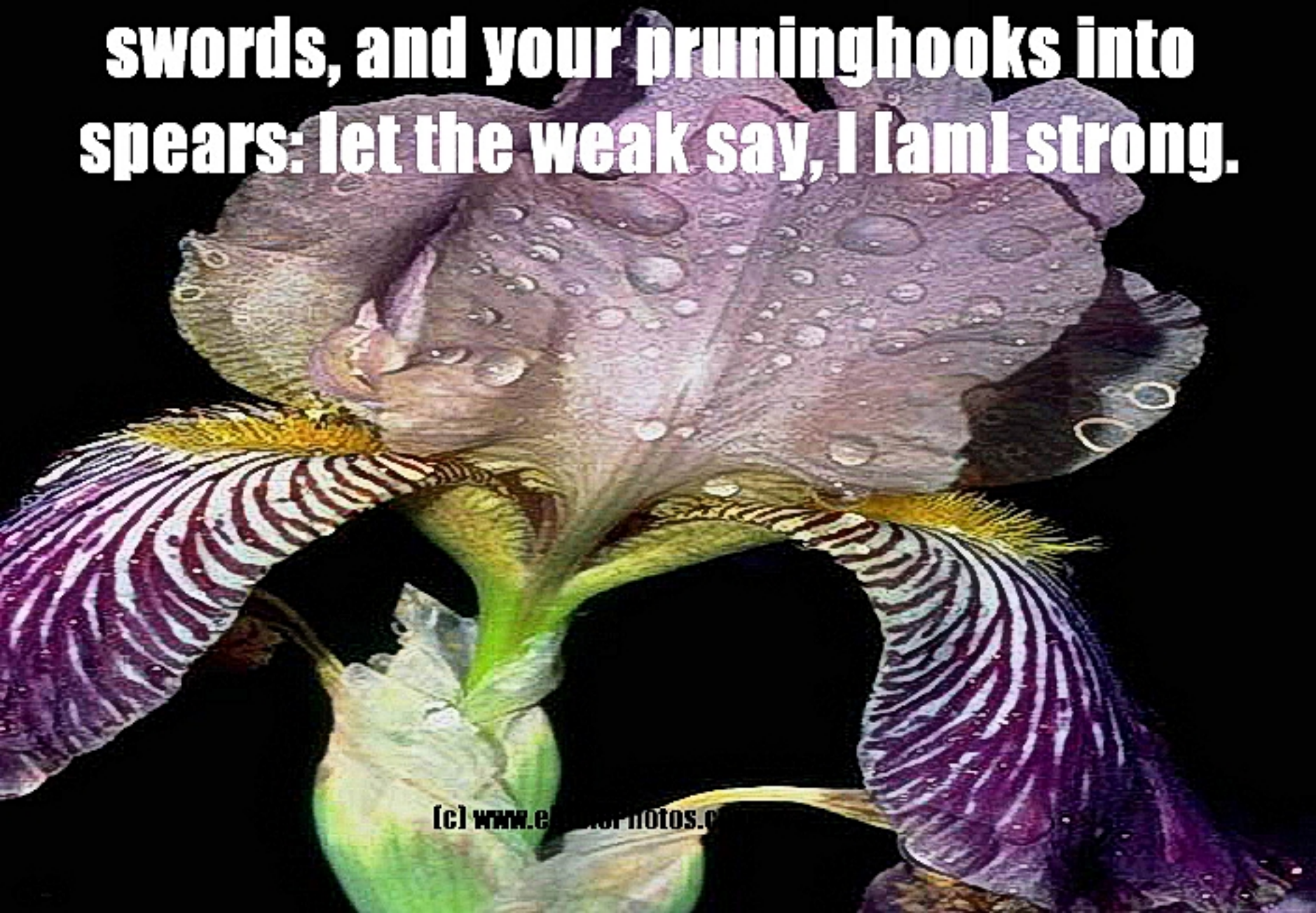
