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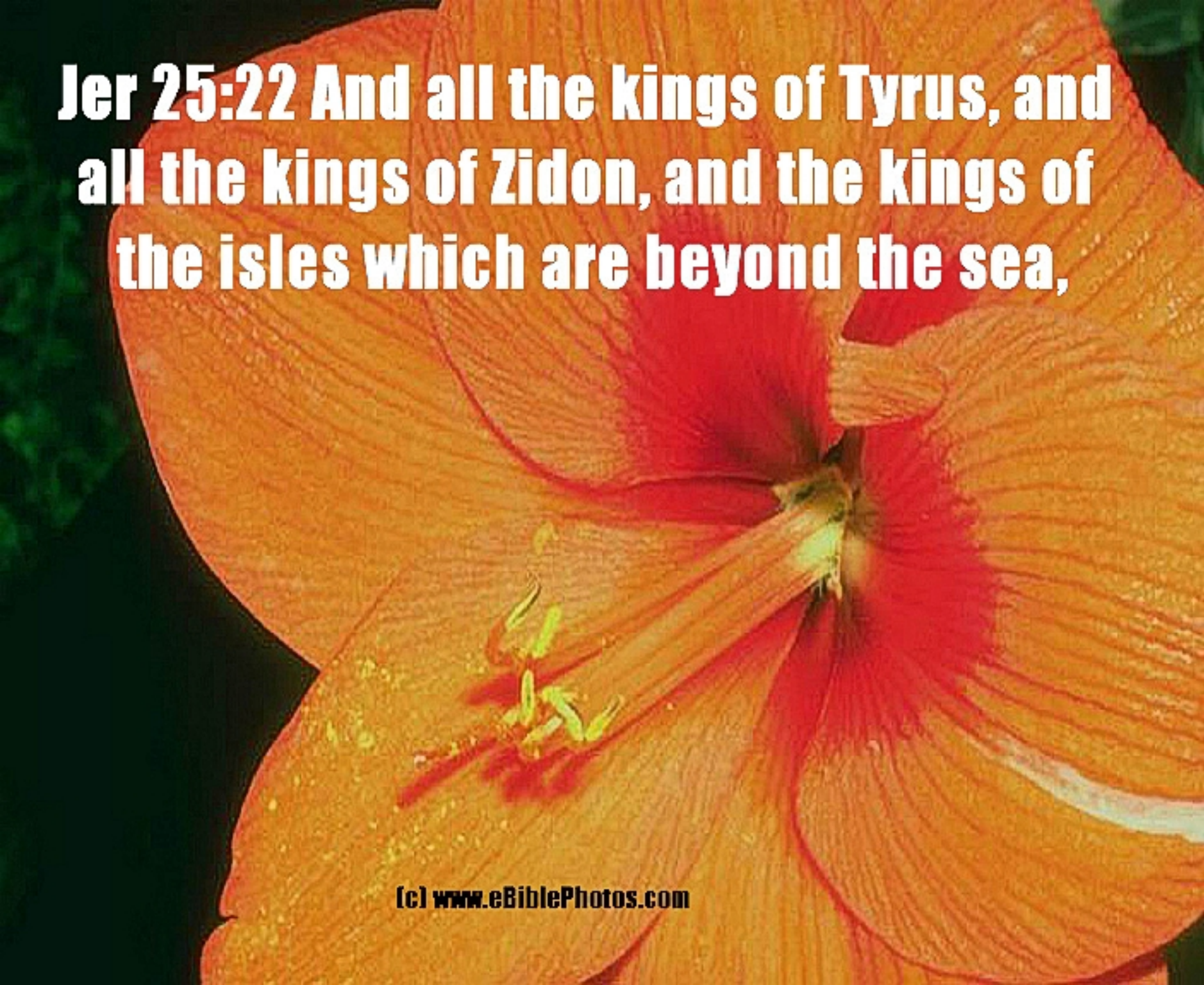




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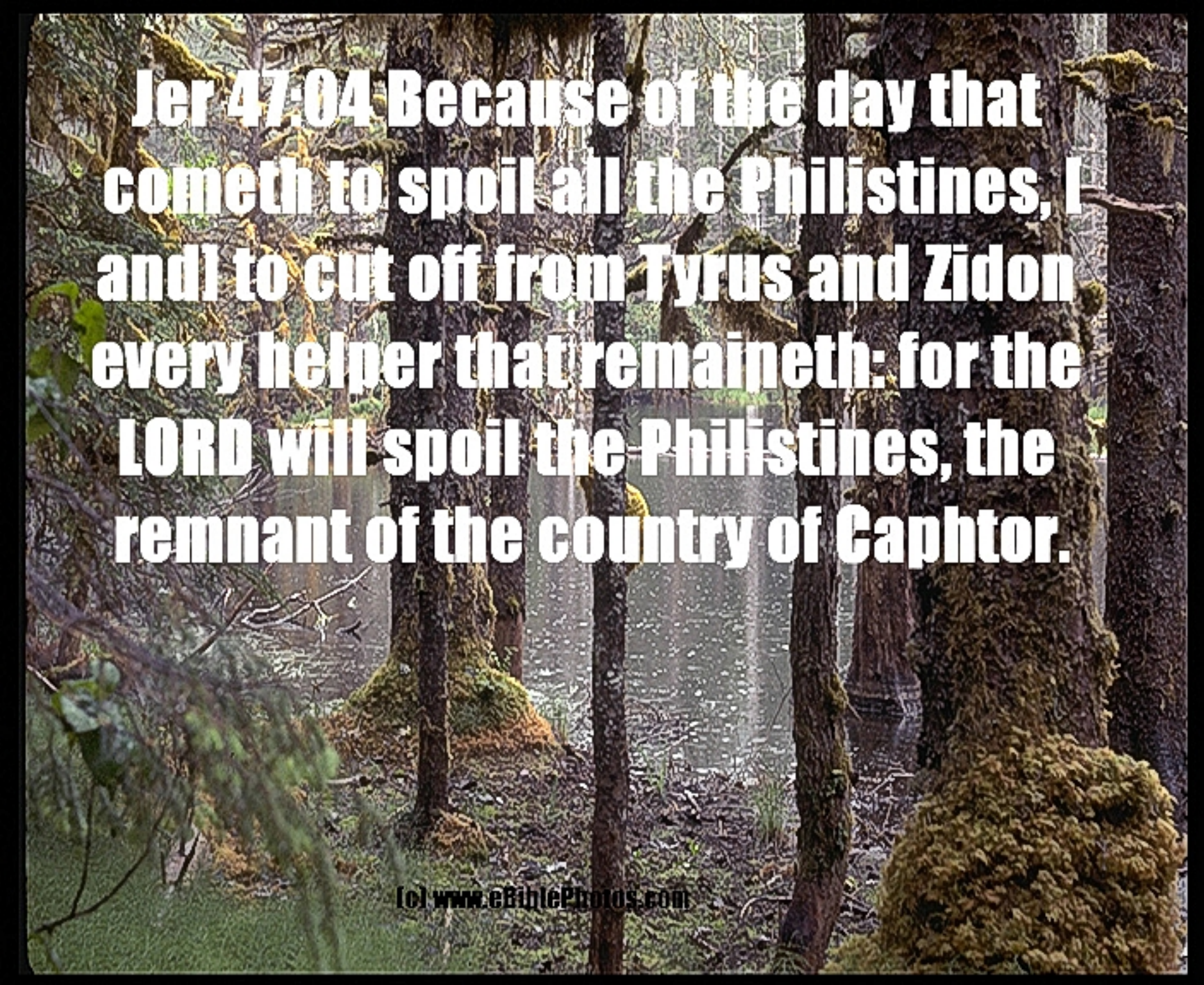

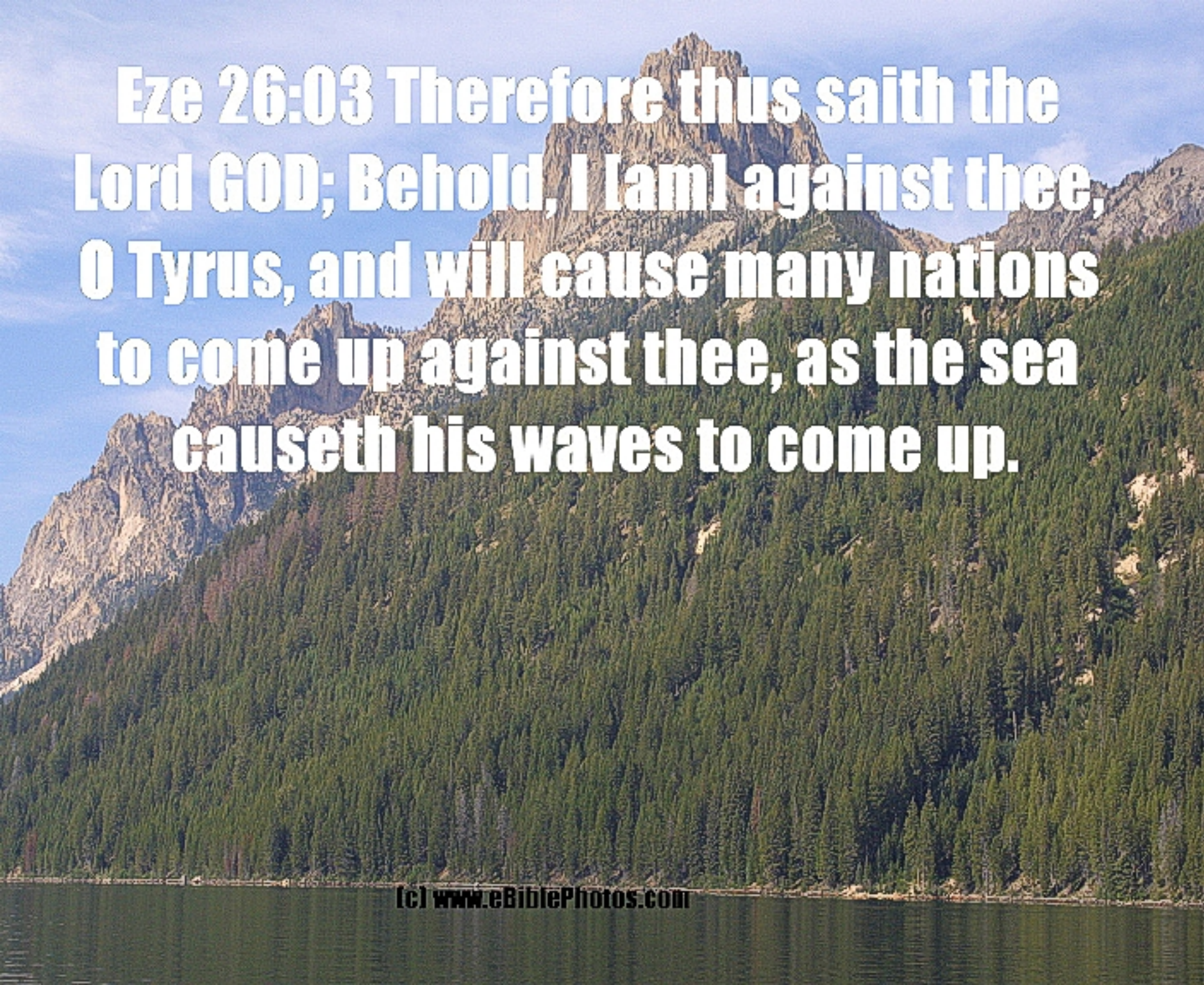
**Jer 25:22 And all the kings of Tyrus, and

the isles which are beyond the sea,**

Jer 27:03 And send them to the king of Edom, and to the king of Moab, and to the king of the Ammonites, and to the king of Tyrus, and to the king of Zidon, by the hand of the messengers which come to Jerusalem unto Zedekiah king of Judah;

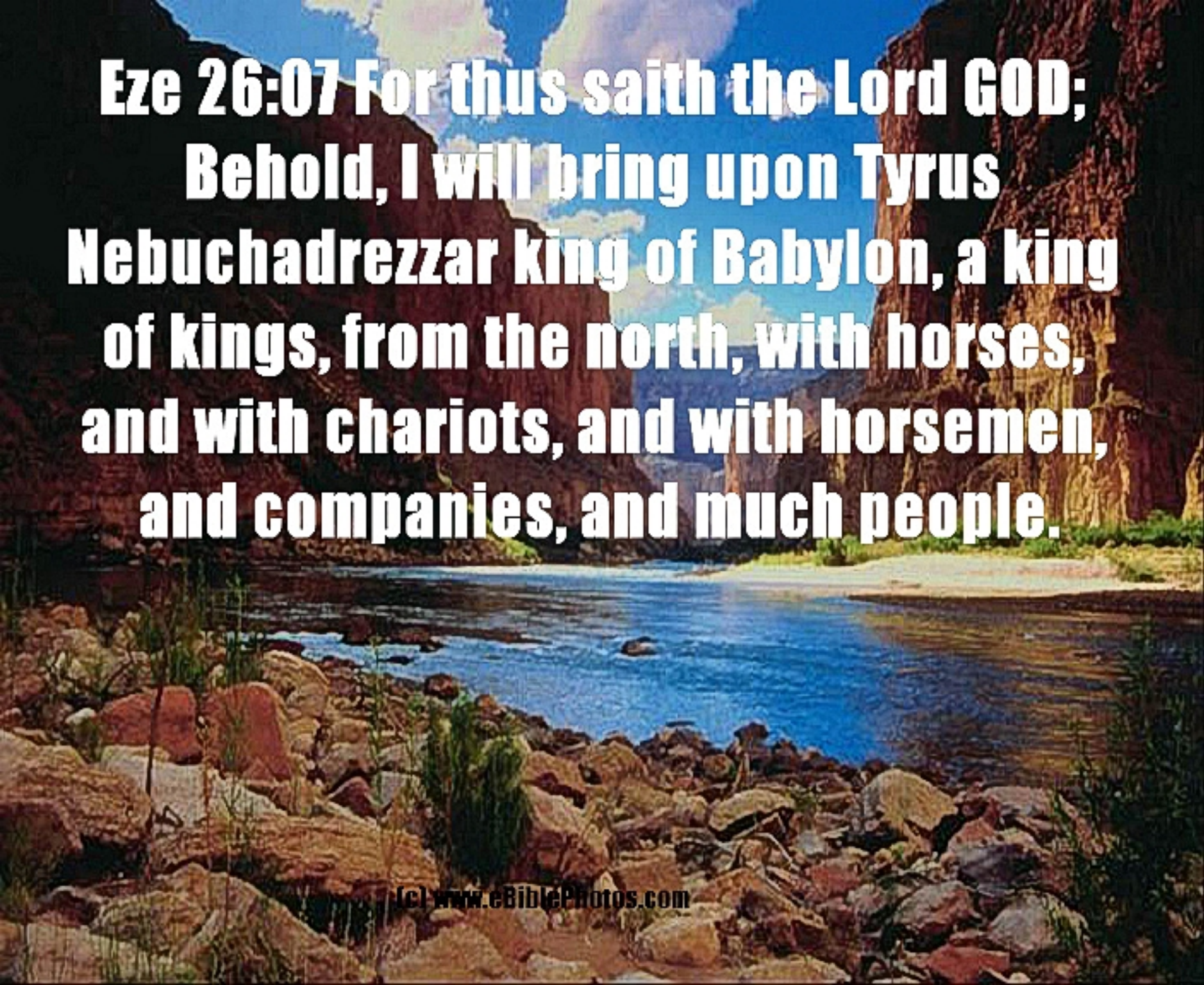
**Jer 47:04 Because of the day that

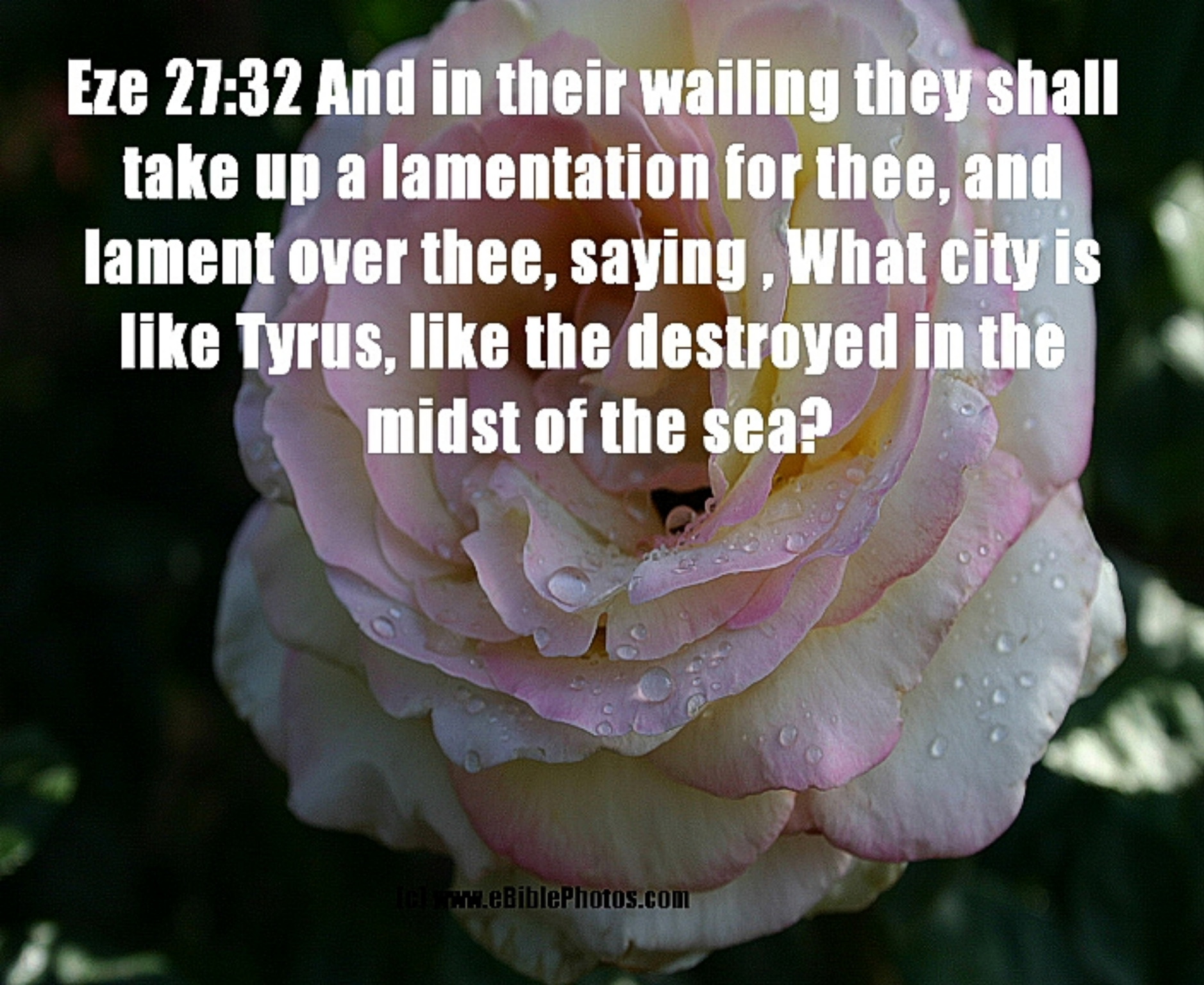
**Eze 26:07 For thus saith the Lord GOD;

midst of thee?**

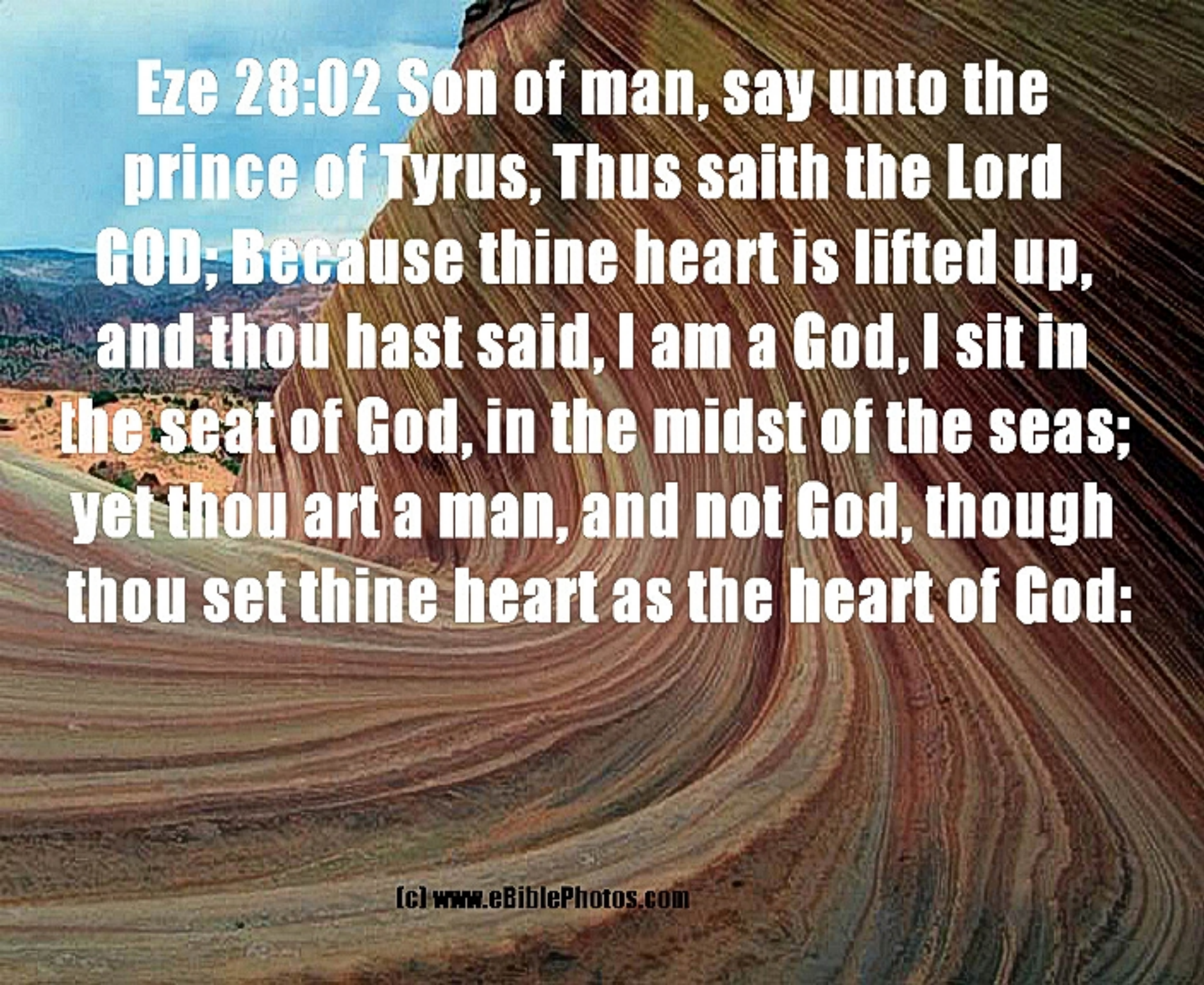
**Eze 27:02 Now, thou son of man, take

perfect beauty.**

**Eze 27:08 The inhabitants of Zidon and
Arvad were thy mariners: thy wise I
men], O Tyrus, [that] were in thee, were
thy pilots.**



**Eze 27:32 And in their wailing they shall
take up a lamentation for thee, and
lament over thee, saying , What city is
like Tyrus, like the destroyed in the
midst of the sea?**



Eze 28:02 Son of man, say unto the prince of Tyrus, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because thine heart is lifted up, and thou hast said, I am a God, I sit in the seat of God, in the midst of the seas; yet thou art a man, and not God, though thou set thine heart as the heart of God:

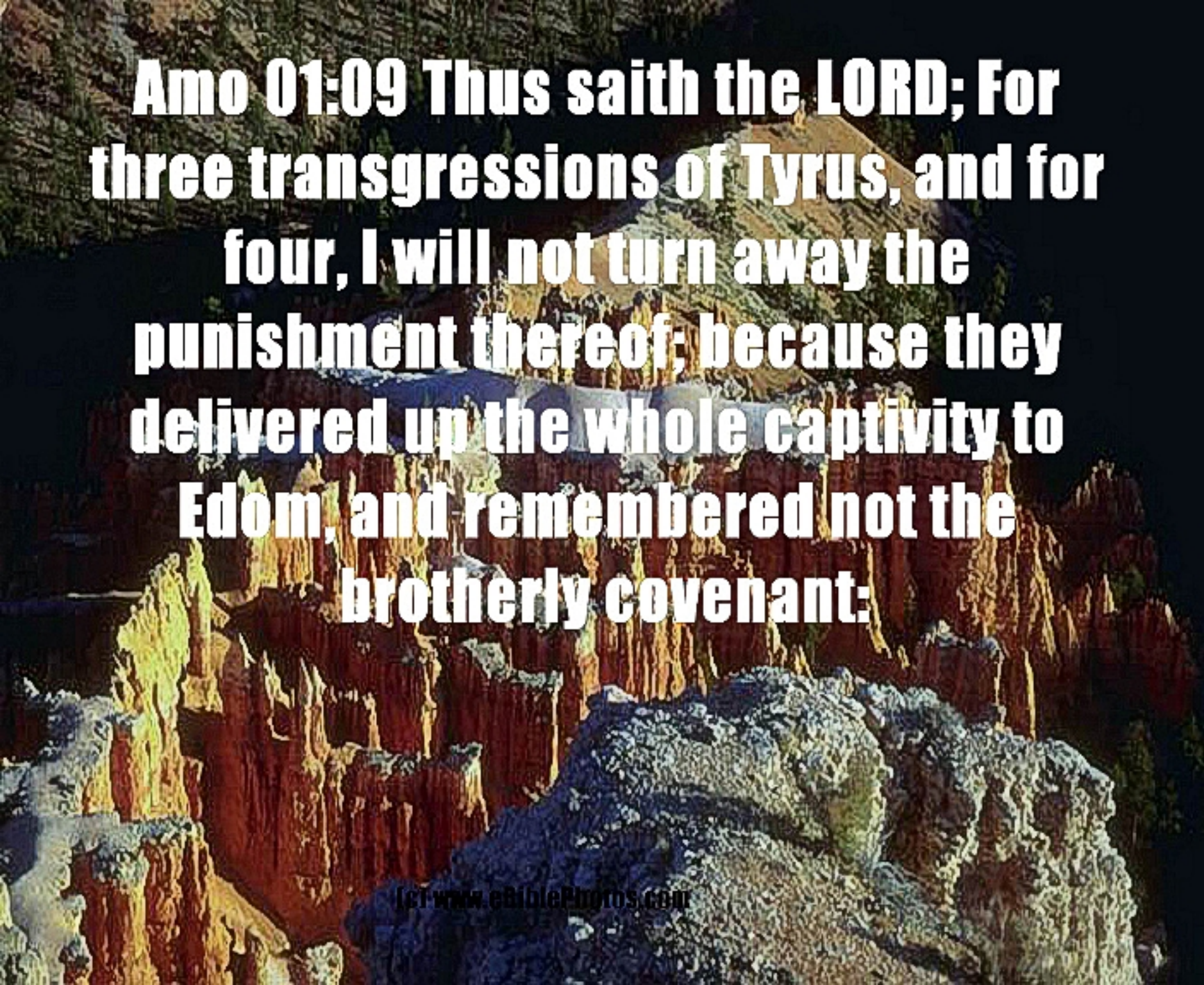

**Eze 28:12 Son of man, take up a
lamentation upon the king of Tyrus,
and say unto him, Thus saith the Lord
GOD; Thou sealest up the sum, full of
wisdom, and perfect in beauty.**

Eze 29:18 Son of man, Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon caused his army to serve a great service against Tyrus: every head was made bald, and every shoulder was peeled: yet had he no wages, nor his army, for Tyrus, for the service that he had served against it:

**Hos 09:13 Ephraim, as I saw Tyrus, is
planted in a pleasant place: but
Ephraim shall bring forth his children
to the murderer.**





**Amo 01:09 Thus saith the LORD; For
three transgressions of Tyrus, and for
four, I will not turn away the
punishment thereof; because they
delivered up the whole captivity to
Edom, and remembered not the
brotherly covenant:**

**Amo 01:10 But I will send a fire on the
wall of Tyrus, which shall devour the
palaces thereof.**

**Zec 09:02 And Hamath also shall
border thereby; Tyrus, and Zidon,
though it be very wise.**

**Zec 09:03 And Tyrus did build herself a
strong hold, and heaped up silver as
the dust, and fine gold as the mire of
the streets.**
