



hand under my thigh:**

halted upon his thigh.**




**Num 05:22 And this water that causeth

Amen, amen.**



Jud 03:21 And Ehud put forth his left hand, and took the dagger from his right thigh, and thrust it into his belly:






**Jud 15:08 And he smote them hip and

and thy majesty.**


**Son 03:08 They all hold swords, [being]
