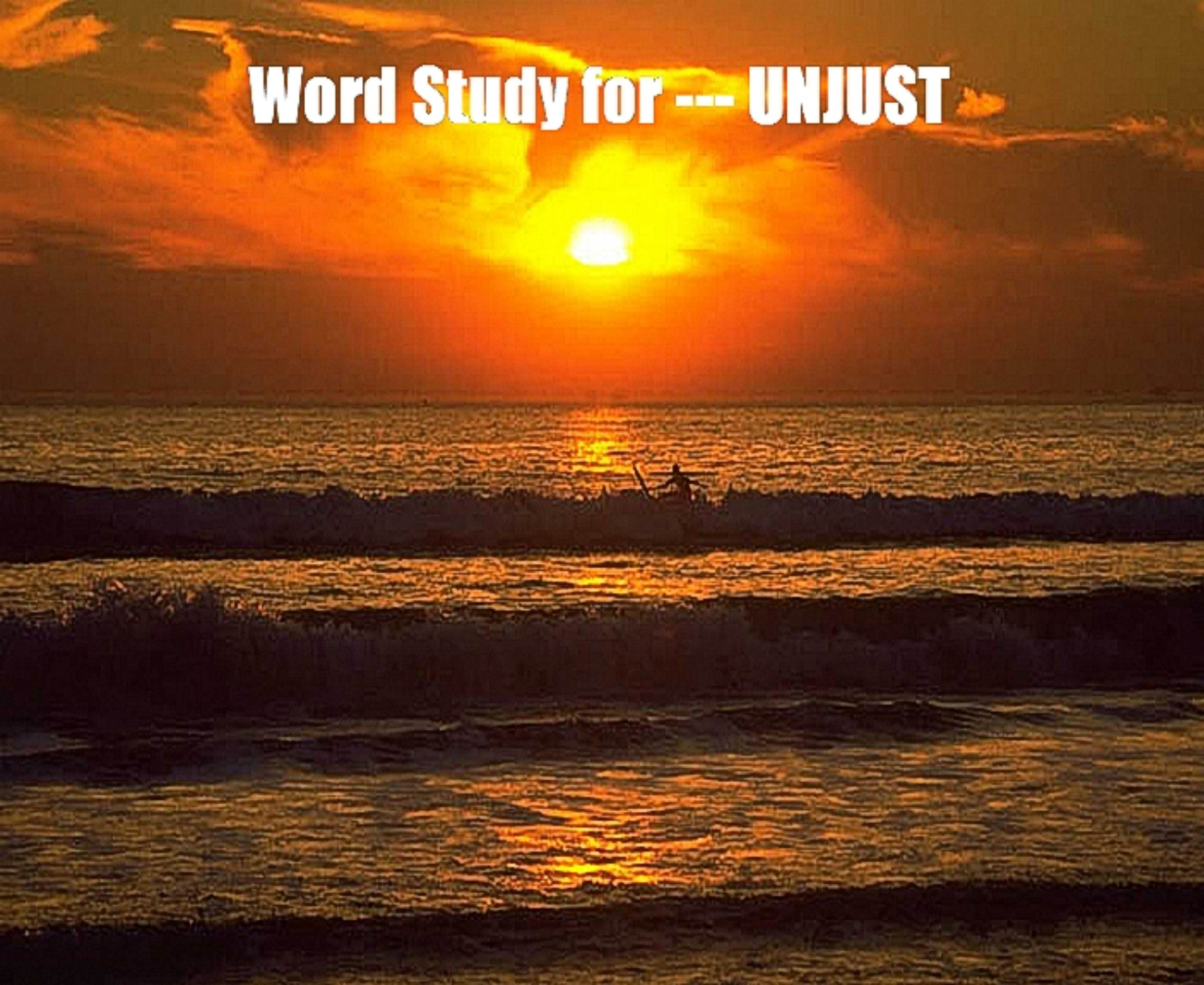




Word Study for --- UNJUST






