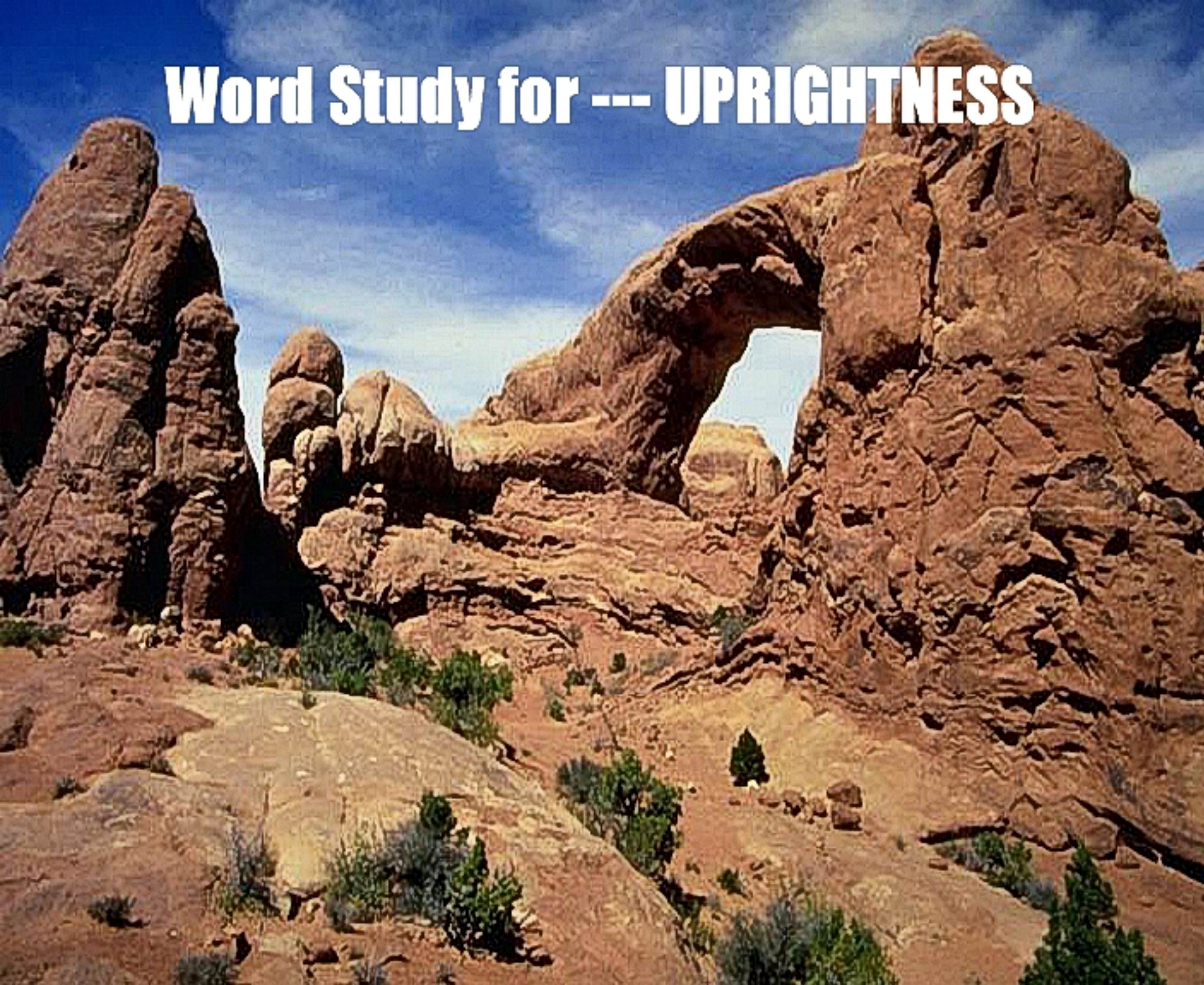






**Deu 09:05 Not for thy righteousness,




